ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government introduced Generator Subsidy for micro, small and medium enterprises at the rate of 25% of the cost of generators upto 125 KVA capacity subject to a maximum of Rs.1.50 lakh. In the Government order second read above, retrospective effect to Government order first read above with effect from 11.11.2008 was given. In the Government order third read above, orders were issued duly enhancing the ceiling of subsidy amount from Rs.1.50 lakh to Rs.5.00 lakh and the capacity of generator sets from 125 KVA to 320 KVA with retrospective effect from 11.11.2008.

2. The Principal Secretary / Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has stated that as on 30.6.2014, 3532 applications for Generator subsidy to the tune of Rs. 42.32 crores are pending in all the districts. The pending claim includes Rs.5.3226 crores for 400 applications pending with TIIC Limited also.

3. The year-wise applications received for Generator Subsidy, funds allotted for the period from 2009-10 to 30.06.2014 / anticipated upto 30.09.2014 and disbursements made 2013-2014 are given below:

The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce and sanction a sum of Rs.29,00,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty nine crore only) towards the disbursement of Generator Subsidy pending upto 30.06.2014 in all the district for the year 2014-15.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
