**ORDER:**

In the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce's letter first read above, it has been stated that all General Manager's were instructed that only belated applications for issue of Eligibility Certificate for Low Tension Power Tariff subsidy which exceeds the time limit of 3 months alone should be condoned by Director of Industries and Commerce.

2. In the Government letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government has indicated that the condonaton of delay for Low Tension Power Tariff subsidy claim applications at 2<sup>nd</sup> stage is not acceptable. Further para 7.5.6 of the guidelines issued in the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, states that condonation of delay in respect of belated claims in Low Tension Power Tariff subsidy will not be entertained.

3. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, has stated that M/s. Lakshmi Agencies, Rajapalayam obtained Eligibility Certificate for Low Tension Power Tariff subsidy from General Manager, District Industries Centre, Virudhunagar for the period from 15.10.2001 to 14.10.2004. The due date for filing of application for Low Tension Power Tariff subsidy for the period from Feb 2004 to June 2004 is 31.08.2004. But the unit had filed the application on 11.10.2004 after a delay of 41 days due to an accident, in which claimed three lives in the family of the unit holder and certain other labourers related issues.

4. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for delegating powers to him for condoning the delay in respect of filing of the Low Tension Power Tariff claim application by M/s. Lakshmi Agencies, Virudhunagar, as a special case.

5. The Government after careful consideration of the reasons stated by the firm for the delay of 41 days that has occurred in filing Low Tension Power Tariff subsidy claim, have decided to condone the above delay, as a special case and orders accordingly.
