### ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued revising the rate of testing fees prescribed for the various samples undertaken for testing by Chemical Testing and Analytical Laboratory, and Mechanical and Metallurgical Laboratory, Guindy and Regional Testing Laboratories at Madurai, Coimbatore, Salem and Thoothukudi for two years upto 17.10.2004. Further 50% of concession on testing fees was given for samples received from SSI units registered with Industries and Commerce Department. The testing fees approved in the G.O. first read above have been extended upto 17.10.2006 and upto 17.10.2008 vide G.O. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> read above. The proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce for revision of testing fees beyond October 2008 was considered in 2009 and the proposal was deferred by the Government for one year. In the Government letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above as the economy was facing decline in growth rate and Industries especially MSME section was facing difficult times in terms of demand.

2. In the G.O. 5<sup>th</sup> read above orders have been issued revising the rates of testing fees prescribed for the various tests undertaken by Chemical Testing and Analytical Laboratory, Mechanical and Metallurgical Laboratory, Guindy and Regional Testing Laboratories at Coimbatore, Madurai, Salem and Thoothukudi for period of two years from 24.12.2010.

3. In G.O.(4D).No.47, Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (E) Department, dated.20.12.2012 orders were issued revising the rate of Testing Fees prescribed for the various tests undertaken by the Chemical Wing Testing Laboratories for two years with effect from 24.12.2012.

4. In the letter 7<sup>th</sup> read above the Principal Secretary / Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested the Government to issue orders on the following:

- a) To approve the proposed revised rate of testing fees.
- b) The revised rate of testing fees shall take effect from 22.12.2014 for two years.
- c) To extent the 50% concession now offered on testing fees to Micro and Small Industries having E.M. Acknowledgment Part II for another 2 years.

5. The Government after careful consideration accept the request of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in para 4 above and direct that the rates prescribed for the various test undertaken by Chemical Testing and Analytical Laboratory, and Mechanical and Metallurgical Laboratory, Guindy and Regional Testing Laboratories at Madurai, Coimbatore, Salem and Thoothukudi be revised as detailed in the Annexure I-A, I-B, I-C, I-D, II-A, II-B, III, IV, V and VI to this order.

6. The revised rate of testing fees shall take effect from 22.12.2014 for one year.

7. The Government also ordered that the 50% concession now offered on testing fees to Micro and Small Industries having Entrepreneur Memorandum Acknowledgement Part II shall continue for another one year from 22.12.2014.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide U.O.No.65189/ Industries/ 2014, dated.4.12.2014.
