ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government have introduced

a package of incentives and concessions for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises under Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy, 2008. One among the incentive schemes announced in the Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy is the Reimbursement of 50% Stamp duty and Registration charges to Micro and Small Enterprises set up in industrially backward blocks and Government Industrial Estates (excluding Estates within the radius of 50 km distance from Chennai City centre) on purchase of land meant for industrial use as mentioned in Para 4.1.4 of Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy, 2008 and also in Chapter 12 of Guidelines for Administration of Incentives and Concession announced in the Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy, 2008.

2. In the Government order second read above, the Government have notified the exemption granted from payment of Stamp duty and Registration fee in favour of Micro, Small Enterprises sector, Tamilnadu Small Industries Development Corporation Limited or Government developed estates in respect of privately developed estates under Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008. 3. The Principal Secretary / Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has stated that, the following enterprises have satisfactorily completed the criteria for availing the concession prescribed in Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy, 2008 for reimbursement of 50% Stamp duty and Registration charges to Micro and Small Enterprises set up in industrially backward blocks.

4. The Principal Secretary / Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs. 3,11,550/- (Rupees Three lakh eleven thousand five hundred and fifty only) towards Reimbursement of 50% Stamp duty and Registration charges to the above eligible enterprises.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce accord sanction for a sum of Rs. 3,11,550/- (Rupees Three lakh eleven thousand five hundred and fifty only) towards Reimbursement of 50% Stamp duty and Registration charges to eligible Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises as mentioned in para 4 above.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No.44-02:-

2851-00-Village and Small Industries – 102 – Small Scale Industries – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan- II State Plan -MO. Reimbursement of Stamp Duty and Registration Charges – 11. Subsidy - 01. Individual Based Subsidy.

7. The Principal Secretary/Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new head of account opened in para 6 above.

8. The Pay and Accounts Officer/Treasury Officer concerned is requested to open above new head of Account in their accounts.

9. Necessary funds of Rs.3,11,550/- will be provided in RE/FMA, 2015-2016. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2015-2016, the Principal Secretary / Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. The Principal Secretary / Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is requested to include the above additional Expenditure, while sending proposals for amount in the RE/FMA 2015 - 2016 to Government in Finance (Ind) Department without fail. He is requested to send to the utilization certificate to the Government in this regard.
