ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, orders were issued sanctioning a sum of Rs.182 lakhs for implementation of the scheme of re-imburement of charges for acquiring Quality Certification (Q-Cert) during the financial year 2018-2019 which includes Rs.150 lakhs towards re-imburement of Certification charges and Rs.32 lakhs towards conducting awareness programme only in the 1st year of implementation of the scheme.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has stated that the General Managers of District Industries Centre / Regional Joint Director, Chennai were requested to furnish the Q-Cert subsidy applications processed and kept ready for disbursement through online portal as on 30.06.2020. The General Managers of District Industries Centre / Regional Joint Director, Chennai have furnished details of requirement to the tune of Rs.9.37 lakhs is required for clearing pending application with them kept ready for disbursement for the period up to 30.06.2020 and Rs.14.91 lakhs and Rs.77.43 lakhs will be anticipated up to 30.09.2020 and 31.12.2020 respectively. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has further stated that in Demand No.44, the Government have provided token provision of Rs.1000/- (Rupees one thousand only) under the Q-Cert for the year 2020-2021. Considering the number of applications already kept ready for disbursement with District Industries Centres and the applications expected during the year, the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested

the Government to provide a sum of Rs.101.71 lakhs for disbursement of Q-Cert subsidy in the Revised Estimate for the year 2020-2021. In view of the above, the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.1,01,71,000/- (Rupees one crore one lakh and seventy one thousand only) in Revised Estimate over and above in the Budget Estimate of Rs.1000/- for the year 2020-2021 besides authorizing the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce to draw and disburse the amount to all General Manager of District Industries Centres / Regional Joint Director, Chennai for the year 2020-21.

3. The Government after careful examination accepts the proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce. Accordingly, Government sanction a sum of Rs.1,02,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore and two lakh only) towards implementation of the above scheme during in 2020-2021.

4. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount and she is permitted to utilize the above sanctioned amount for the year 2020-2021.

5. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"2851 – 00 Village and Small Industries" – 102 Small Scale Industries State's Expenditure – NA Reimbursement – for acquiring Quality Certification (Q-Cert) – 309 – Grants in Aid 03 – Grants for specific schemes. (IFHRMS DPC 2851 00 102 NA 309 03)" (Old DPC 2851 00 102 NA 0937).

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.1,02,00,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2020-2021. However, this expenditure shall be brought for the notice of the Legislature by **Specific Inclusion** in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021. Pending provision of such funds the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RE/FMA 2020-2021 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2020-2021 to Government in Finance (Industries) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.47049/Finance (Industries)/2020, dated 21.12.2020 and ASL No.1181 (One thousand one hundred and eighty one).
