### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read, above, orders have been issued for enhance the rate of remuneration to Part time Lecturers in Government Technical Training Centre, Guindy and Institute of Tool Engineering, Dindigul at Rs.200/- per hour for theory classes and Rs.100/- per hour for practical classes subject to maximum limit of Rs.10,000/- per month with effect from 28.11.2011. i.e. the date of re-opening of even Polytechnic Colleges functioning under Higher Education Department.

2. In the letter third read above Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has informed that the Government Technical Training under the academic control of Department of Technical Education (DOTE), Chennai-2! R & AC) Courses which are approved by the All India Council for Technical Education (AlCTE) and the courses are being conducted as per the syllabus prescribed intake.

3. In Government Technical Training Centre, Guindy, Chennai-32, second and 3. In Government Technical Training Centre, Carrier, Salling, Strength by Assistant Engineers third year i.e., III, IV, V and VI Semester subjects are taught by Assistant Engineers and Junior Engineers of the Department (Sanctioned Strength = 10 and Junior Engineers of the Department (Sanctioned Science Subjects and Science Subject Subjects and Science Subject Subjects and Science Subject Subj Strength = 4). The first year subjects such as Communication of the first year subjects and such as be handled by Post Graduates in English Literature and Science subjects and such as be handled by Post Graduates in English Literature and their respective practical have to be Engineering Chemistry, Engineering Physics and their respective practical have to be Engineering Unemistry, Engineering Physics and thom sprescribed by AICTE. Specialized subjects of Government Technical Training Centre staff themselves. V & VI Semester DME (R & A/C) course such as Refrigeration, Air–conditioning R&A/C Estimation and Design and their respective labs have to be handled by persons with field-experience and M.E. (Refrigeration and Air – conditioning) qualification as per AICTE norms. Hence, part time lectures are being employed. There is no regular staff sanctioned to Institute of Tool Engineering, Dindigul to conduct 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester subjects. Hence, as done in the previous years, part time lecturers are engaged on hourly basis on payment of Honorarium @ Rs.200/- per hour for theory subjects and Rs.100/- per hour for practical subjects as per existing Government Order G.O.(2D)No.27, MS&ME Department, dated 18.09.2012. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has further informed that for handling of second and third year i.e., III, IV, V and VI Semester classes, three Assistant Engineer (Industries), two Junior Engineer (Industries) and two Die makers posts are sanctioned in the Institute of Tool Engineering Dindigul, but presently all the above posts are vacant. The part time lecturers are involved in theoretical and practical classes.

4.The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has pointed out that in the Government order second read above the remuneration to Part time Lecturers working in Government Polytechnic Colleges functioning under classes and Rs.150/- per hour for practical classes subject to the maximum limit of Rs.15,000/- per month.

5. On revising the remuneration to the part time lecturers as per the G.O. (D) Department, Dated 14.06.2017, total annual fund 10,212, Higher Education (II) No.212. Department, Dated 1 audirement as submitted by both Training Institutes are:
