ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the Director Madras Institute of Development Studies has forwarded the proposal for Enhancing Research Capacity for Systematic and Scientific Sample Surveys for Understanding Socio-Economic Development in Tamil Nadu.

2. In the Government letter second read above the Principal Secretary/ Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics was instructed to take up the project of “Tamil Nadu House Hold panel Survey” under TANII and also requested to send necessary proposal to State Planning Commission for funding.

3. The Principal Secretary/ Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics placed the proposal of Tamil Nadu House hold Panel Survey” and it has been appraised by the State Planning Commission. Tamil Nadu Household Panel Survey is for enhancing Research capacity for systematic and scientific sample surveys for understanding socio-economic development in Tamil Nadu. The proposed study would provide timely new information to policy makers and the public on social and economic development. The Survey data would be made publicly available to researchers and analysts in the state. The programme will provide outreach, training and user support to help new data analysts access the data and use it effectively. The total project cost is Rs.480.00 lakhs for a period of three years. The survey is to be implemented in two phases and the first phase of the survey is to “Establish the Baseline”.

The second phase survey which is also a follow up survey will be done with the gap of one or two years after the completion of the first phase baseline survey.

4. The State Planning Commission, after detailed deliberation is of the view that the new "Tamil Nadu Household Panel Survey" (TNHPS) would provide timely new information for policymakers and the public on social and economic development and well being with the State of Tamil Nadu. The Staff of the Department of Economics and Statistics would be involved in the study and the cost of the survey is restricted to Rs.390.00 lakhs. Therefore, the State Planning Commission recommended the proposal for consideration under TANII for the year 2015-2016 at a total cost of Rs.390.00 lakhs for a period of three years. The cost in 2015-16 would be Rs.10.00 lakhs.

5. The Government after careful consideration accord sanction for the cost of the project of Rs.390.00 lakhs as recommended by the SPC and releases a sum of Rs.10.00 lakhs as the first year cost in 2015-2016 for undertaking the "Tamil Nadu House hold Panel Survey".

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
