## ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner has informed that the Government of India, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi has requested Government of Tamil Nadu to conduct Training programme on digitization of Phase II Agriculture Census 2015-16 and Phase III Input Survey 2016-2017 for Southern Region consisting of the States namely Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Puducherry, Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands in Tamil Nadu during 17<sup>th</sup> – 20<sup>th</sup> July 2018. India has also stated that the expenditure incurred on the training programme may be charged under the 'Office Expenses' head of the Agriculture Census Scheme.

- 2. The Additional Chief Secretary to Government/Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics, has also stated that 25 officials, including 2 officers, each from participating States, Officers of NIELIT (National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology), Officers of Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers welfare, Government of India and participants from our state are to participate in the Training Programme intended for providing exposure to data entry software, data scrutiny and Input Survey (Phase III) training to the field level officials of our State. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above Government of India have revalidated the unspent amount lying with the State as on 01.04.2018 to be spent in 2018-2019. In the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above Government of India have released a sum of Rs. 9.25 lakhs (Revalidation Rs.4.25 lakh and 1<sup>st</sup> instalment Rs.5.00 lakhs under the component Office Expenses)
- 3. The Government after careful examination, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.4,25,000/- (Rupees Four lakh and twenty five thousands only) towards conduct of training Programme on digitalization of Phase II Agriculture Census and Phase III input survey for the Southern Region as requested by Government of India in the reference fourth cited.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2401-00-Crop Husbandry – 111 Agricultural Economics and Statistics Central Sector Schemes – SA Agricultural Census – 05 Office Expenses – 02 Other Contingencies (DPC 2401 – 00-111-SA-0526)".

- 5. Necessary additional funds to the tune of Rs.4,25,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2018-2019. Pending provision of such funds, the Additional Chief Secretary / Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above. The Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics is requested to include the above expenditure while sending the proposals for Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2018-2019 to Government in Finance (Public) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
- 6. The Additional Chief Secretary/Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics is authorised to draw the amount sanctioned in para 3 above as advance under Article 99 of the TNFC Vol I and requested to adjust it with detailed bills and vouchers as soon as possible.
