ORDER:

In the Government Order fourth read above, a sum of Rs.97.80 lakhs was sanctioned for implementation of Renewable Energy schemes in Coimbatore, Dindigul, Theni and Virudhunagar Districts under Western Ghats Development Programme for the year 2013-2014.

2) In the letter fifth read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency has sent proposals to Government for the year 2014-2015 for an amount of Rs.143.20 lakhs for implementation of Renewable Energy schemes in Coimbatore, Tiruppur, Dindigul, Theni, Madurai, Virudhunagar, Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Districts under Western

Ghats Development Programme for the year 2014-2015. After detailed examination, the proposal of Rs.143.20 lakhs is recommended to the Union Planning Commission, Government of India for approval. In the letter sixth read above, the Union Planning Commission, Government of India has approved an amount of Rs.143.200 lakhs to the Renewable Energy schemes under Western Ghats Development Programme for the year 2014-2015.

- 3) The Government, after careful consideration, accord sanction for incurring an expenditure of Rs.143.20 lakhs (Rupees One Crore Forty Three Lakhs and Twenty Thousand only) for implementation of Renewable Energy schemes in Coimbatore, Tiruppur, Dindigul, Theni, Madurai, Virudhunagar, Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Districts through the Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency under Western Ghats Development Programme during the year 2013-2014 as detailed in the Annexure-I to this order. The Director of Agriculture is requested to implement the schemes in Tiruppur District in Co-ordination with the District Rural Development Agency, Tiruppur District and in respect of Kanniyakumari District, the District Collector, District Rural Development Agency, Nagercoil shall implement the Co-ordination with the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency. The details of watersheds selected for the year 2014-2015 have been indicated in the Annexure - II to this order.
- 4) The expenditure sanctioned in para-3 above shall be debited under the following head of account under Demand No.5:
 - "4402. 00 CAPITAL OUTLAY ON SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION 800. Other Expenditure SCHEMES IN TWELFTH FIVE YEAR PLAN– II. State Plan KA. Implementation of Western Ghats Development Programme through Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency 16. Major works" (DPC 4402 00 800 KA 1607).
 - 5) Necessary additional funds of Rs.143.20 lakhs will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation, 2014-2015. Pending provision of such funds in Final Modified Appropriation, 2014-2015, the Director of Agriculture is permitted to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-3 above for the implementation of Renewable Energy schemes. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of legislature by specific inclusion in the final Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015. The Director of Agriculture is requested to include this expenditure while sending the proposal of Final Modified Appropriation, 2014-2015 and also to send necessary Explanatory note for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015 to Government in Finance (Agri/BG-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

- 6) The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency shall implementing the renewable energy schemes to the concerned Districts and to complete all the works within this financial year. Further, he shall also consult the respective District Collectors in respect of selection of sites for the installation of the devices as detailed in the Annexure-I to this order. The Government also directs the District Collectors to issue specific instructions to the concerned local bodies in which the devices are to be installed for the proper maintenance of the same.
- 7) It shall be ensured that detailed estimates with Project Report are available for each item of work prior to disbursement and a copy submitted to the Collector of the concerned district in advance for monitoring. Where relevant, a baseline survey, user needs and beneficiary identification along with relevant details of watershed features, land use and likely impacts should form part of the Project Report so submitted. In cases where works are, dependent on site selection with public participation, which should invariably be the case, the details with photographic evidence and supporting remote sensing maps should be provided in the Project Report. Finally, upon completion of the project, a completion report with photographs and factual report of use, impact, beneficiary feedback should be sent along with financial details of utilization and balance surrendered including for works accounted under Letter of Credit method.
- 8) As ordered in the Government order first read above, the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency and the District Collectors, Coimbatore, Tiruppur, Dindigul, Theni, Madurai, Virudhunagar, Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Districts shall watch the implementation of the schemes and requested to send the monthly Progress Report by 15th of every month without delay. They are also requested to furnish the list of beneficiaries along with identification details (scheme wise) for beneficiary oriented schemes in the prescribed format soon after the close of the financial year.
- 9) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.2640/Fin(Agri)Department/2015,dated.21.01.2015 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.2264[Two Thousand Two Hundred and Sixty Four]
