ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, orders have been issued for constituting State and District Level Co-ordination Committee to ensure effective co-ordination amongst line departments for smooth and timely completion of $10^{\rm th}$ Agriculture Census under the Chairmanship of the Principal Secretary to Government, Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Department.

In the letter second read above, Government of India have requested to constitute a State Level Co-ordination Committee (SLCC) in the State and have its meeting convened on regular intervals so that impediments in completion of different constituent activities of Agriculture Census 2020-21 could be discussed and sorted out for timely completion along with Committees at District level by including representatives from Revenue Administration Department, Agriculture Department, Department of Economics and Statistics, NIC and e-governance Agency.

In the letter third read above, the Commissioner, Department of Economics and Statistics has requested the Government to constitute a State Level Co-ordination committee and District Level Co-ordination Committee for better co-ordination, monitoring, smooth and timely completion of Eleventh Agriculture Census 2020-21 and also to fix targets for inspection to the supervisory officials in connection with the Eleventh Agricultural Census 2020-2021.

Government after careful consideration, constitute a State Level Co-ordination Committee under the Chairmanship of Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Planning Development and Special Initiatives Department and District Level Coordination Committee for better coordination, monitoring, smooth and timely completion of Eleventh Agriculture Census 2021-22

The District Revenue Officer and the Tahsildar are the overall responsible for completion of field work, as per time schedule in their respective District / Taluk. Further, the Commissioner of Revenue Administration is requested to review the progress of 11th Agriculture Census work and send the status report to Additional Chief Secretary, Planning and Development Department and Commissioner of Department of Economics and Statistics, every month, till the Completion of 11th Agriculture Census.
