  - vi. Review of District Indicator Framework (DIF) and strategies for districts with lower than State average, Preparation of DIF report;
  - vii. Share best practices on the SDG website along with data updation and make this part of the communication plan of the departments;
  - viii. Implementation road map for achieving SDG indicator targets by the departments;
  - ix. Periodic meetings once in a quarter to review the progress;
  - Review the status and report sector wise achievements / shortfalls to the High Power Committee;
  - xi. Need for overall working group level performance reporting against targets to improve SDG index;

- xii. Financial allocation mapping against SDGs;
- xiii. Any other assignment given by the High Power Committee.
