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#### **ORDER:**

Good Governance Index is a comprehensive and implementable framework to assess the state of governance in all States and UTs which enables ranking of States / Districts and present a comparative picture.

2. The Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG), Government of India releases Good Governance Index at National level. At State level, DARPG in association with Government of Jammu & Kashmir had released the first District Good Governance Index (DGGI) Report for the country during January, 2022.

3. The objective is to develop a comprehensive, measurable and implementable DGGI encompassing administrative, economic, social, environmental, legal / judicial and other essential criteria to assess the status of governance mechanism at district level based on which Districts will be ranked first and present a comparative picture for prompt actions.

4. In the Government of India letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Secretary, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, DARPG, shared the copy of the publication on DGGI for Jammu & Kashmir stating that the Index helps identify the impact of various governance interventions at district level and provide a futuristic roadmap for improving district level governance with targeted interventions for perusal and appropriate consideration.

5. Accordingly, it has been proposed to develop a DGGI for the State of Tamil Nadu, which to a large extent will help in identifying grey areas of a district and thereby taking measures to rectify the same for improving the overall governance across districts.

6. The Department of Economics and Statistics had been entrusted with the task of framing the design and development of the District Good Governance Index for the State of Tamil Nadu.

7. In the reference 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Secretariat departments were requested to offer comments / feedback on the proposed design and development of DGGI for the State of Tamil Nadu.

8. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, dated: 29.06.2022 the Commissioner of Economics and Statistics, Chennai-6 has forwarded a revised proposal on "The Design and Development of District Good Governance Index (DGGI) for the State of Tamil Nadu" duly taking into consideration the feedback received from the Secretariat departments.

9. The DGGI for the State of Tamil Nadu is structured on the Good Governance Index of Department of Administrative Reforms and Public Grievances (DARPG), Government of India 2021 and the DGGI Framework of Government of Jammu & Kashmir 2021-2022 and customized by incorporating State specific modifications.

10. The 75 key indicators identified under 10 vital sectors of various departments forms the basis for DGGI framework. The 75 indicators identified for Tamil Nadu fall under the same 10 Sectors construed for District Good Governance Index (DGGI) – Jammu & Kashmir with 31 common indicators, 34 indicators taken from the State SDG – District Indicator Framework (DIF) and 10 new indicators.

Unlike Jammu & Kashmir wherein equal weightages have been assigned to all the 10 sectors, differential weightages have been assigned for the DGGI of Tamil Nadu, mainly based on the relevance of the indicator along the lines of its need for societal development and also considering the necessity to draw developmental paths in the current system.

11. The identified 75 Indicators have been classified as "Impact Indicators" [25] with a value of 0.2 and "Support Indicators" [50] with a value of 0.1.

Outcome / Output-based indicators are classified under Impact Indicators while Proxy Indicators are classified under Support Indicators. The 25 Impact Indicators have been prioritized considering their significance in strengthening the needy areas to promote progress for the betterment of the State's position in all aspects at All-India level.

- (ii) Performance of Districts to be assessed and ranks accorded based on DGGI Indicator Framework.
- (iii) Ranking is to be taken up initially with the reference year as 2020-21.

- (iv) The best performing district is to be recognized by giving Awards.
- (v) DGGI to be modified in successive years by suitable iterations as required.

The sector-wise list of Impact / Support indicators is enclosed as Annexure-II to this Government order.

The Methodology for computation of Ranks and Normalization of indicator values is enclosed as Annexure-III to this Government order.



### Design and Development of District Good Governance Index for the State of Tamil Nadu

#### Methodology for Computation of Ranks and Normalization of Indicator Values :

Dimensional Score for Positive Indicators

$$\text{Score} = \frac{(\text{Indicator Value} - \text{Minimum value})}{(\text{Maximum Value} - \text{Minimum value})}$$

Dimensional Score for Negative Indicators

$$\text{Score} = \frac{(\text{Maximum Value} - \text{Indicator value})}{(\text{Maximum Value} - \text{Minimum value})}$$

Where,

Positive Indicator = for which Higher values is better

Negative Indicator = for which Lower values is better

Indicator Value = Available through Secondary Sources

Maximum Value = Highest Indicator Value among the Districts

Minimum value = Lowest Indicator Value among the Districts

These equations will be directly used by taking the values of indicators for reference year. In case of the Growth-based indicators, this exercise will be undertaken after calculating Compound Annual Growth Rate (CAGR) over base year to reference year for each Indicator.

$$\text{CAGR} = (\text{Value of Reference Year} / \text{Value of Base Year})^{(1/n)-1} \times 100$$

Where, n = number of periods

After completing data normalization process, the normalized value of each indicator is to be multiplied with weightage assigned to the indicator in order to obtain the final indicator score. These final individual indicator scores are to be aggregated to obtain the value for the sector following **Laspeyres** formula on Weighted Average.

The aggregated sector-wise scores become District's DGGI score to be used for ranking purpose. For the computation of scores, 2020-2021 will be taken as the Reference year.

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
