# ORDER:

In the Government Order fifth read above, the Government enhanced the value of scholarship amount from Rs.1500/- per annum to Rs.3000/- per annum for the benefit of cadets belonging to Tamil Nadu, undergoing training in Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun.

- 2. In the Government Order sixth read above, the Government enhanced the value of scholarship amount from Rs.3000/- per annum to Rs.12,000/- per annum to the students studying at Rashtriya Indian Military College, Dehradun.
- 3. In the reference seventh read above, the Commandant, Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC), Dehradun, among others, has stated that as such the cadets are paying approximately Rs.40,000/- per annum. There are four cadets of Tamil Nadu studying from Class 8<sup>th</sup> to Class 12<sup>th</sup> in Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC) per year. He has requested that the State Scholarship of Rs.12,000/- per annum being awarded to the cadet belongs from the State of Tamil Nadu be revised to a level as deemed fit and will meet the requirement of the cadet studying there. He has stated that it would go a very long way in motivating the youth to avail such a premier education facility and to join the Armed Forces.

- 4. The Government after careful examination, hereby order for the enhancement of scholarship amount from Rs.12,000/- (Rupees twelve thousand only) per annum to Rs.40,000/- (Rupees forty thousand only) per annum for the students belonging to Tamil Nadu studying in Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC), Dehradun from the current year.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following head of account :

"2202 General Education - 03 University and Higher Education - 107 Scholarship - I. Non-Plan - AA Scholarship Awarded by the State Government - 12 Scholarships and Stipends - 09 Other". (DPC 2202 - 03 - 107 - AA - 1299).

- 6. The Director of Collegiate Education is authorised to draw and disburse the expenditure sanctioned at para 4 above as per the existing orders and procedures.
