Public Holiday for Id–ul-Fitr (Ramzan) declared on 16.06.2018 under Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government ordered Friday, the 15th of June 2018 as a Public Holiday on account of Id–ul-Fitr (Ramzan) under Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. In the letter 2nd read above, the Chief Kazi to Government of Tamil Nadu has stated that the moon was not sighted on 14.06.2018, and that Ramzan Eid will be celebrated on Saturday the 16th June 2018 and requested to declare the public holiday on Saturday the 16th of June 2018 instead of 15th June 2018.

2. The Government, after careful consideration of the matter have decided to declare 16th June 2018 as a Public Holiday on account of Id–ul-Fitr (Ramzan) instead of 15th June 2018 under Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in an extra-ordinary Gazette dated 14.06.2018.

NOTIFICATION

3. Under the Explanation to Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Central Act XXVI of 1881) read with Notification of the

Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs No.20-25-26, Public-1, dated 8^{th} June 1957 the Government of Tamil Nadu hereby declares that Saturday the 16^{th} June 2018 would be a Public Holiday on account of Id—ul-Fitr (Ramzan) instead of 15^{th} June 2018.

4. The above Public Holiday notified shall also apply to all State Government Undertakings / Corporations / Boards, etc.
