# **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, the Government ordered that Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> of December 2016 as a Government Holiday for Milad—un–Nabi under Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. The Chief Kazi to Government of Tamil Nadu in their letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above has stated that the crescent of the Rabiul Awal was sighted on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2016 and that the Milad-un-Nabi will be celebrated on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December 2016 and not on Monday, the 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016 and requested to declare the public holiday on Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> of December 2016.

2. The Government, after careful consideration of the matter have decided to declare 13<sup>th</sup> December 2016 as a Public Holiday for Milad-un-Nabi instead of 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016 under Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in an extra-ordinary Gazette dated 08.12.2016.

#### **NOTIFICATION**

Under the Explanation to Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Central Act XXVI of 1881) read with Notification of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs No.20-25-26, Public-1, dated 8<sup>th</sup> June 1957 the Government of Tamil Nadu hereby declares that Tuesday the 13<sup>th</sup> December 2016 would be a Public Holiday on account of Milad-un-Nabi instead of 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016.

3. The above Public Holiday notified shall also apply to all State Government Undertakings / Corporations / Boards, etc.
