ORDER:

The Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Plan Formulation in his letter read above has stated that Sembakulam anicut is situated about 1.50 Km south west of Papampatti village of Palani Taluk across Kudhiraiyar river. This is the second anicut in the system. The anicut is century years old and no rehabilitation works were carried out. Due to unprecedented heavy rain during the previous years one portion of anicut is completely damaged and balance portion is dilapidated. Hence sufficient quantity of water could not be received in the channels which affect the ayacuts. He has also stated that the proposal for restoration of Sembakulam anicut consists of construction of the Skin wall, provision of downstream apron with cut off walls and construction of retaining walls in the upstream and downstream anicut. By implementing this scheme, an extent of 453.62 acres direct irrigated Ayacut and 46.26 acres indirect ayacut will be benefited. The cost of scheme for the schedule of rate 2010-2011 works out to Rs.30.00 lakhs and this work will be executed by the Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Coimbatore Region. Hence no additional staff will be required for executing the scheme.

2. The above scheme is approved by the Standing Finance Committee under Part II Schemes for the year 2010-2011. Accordingly, the Government accord administrative sanction for the restoration of Sembakulam anicut in Reddiyampatti village of Palani Taluk in Dindigul District at a total cost of Rs.30.00 lakhs (Rupees Thirty lakhs only). Petty

Supervision charges and unforeseen items should not exceed 2.5% of total cost of works.

3. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph-2 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

Rehabilitation, Renovation and modernisation Irrigation structures – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – II. State Plan – JA. Restoration of Sembakulam anicut in Reddiyampatti village of Palani Taluk of Dindigul District – 16. Major Works” (DP code 4701 – 03 – 422 – JA 1605).

4. The Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Coimbatore Region is requested to take up the work immediately and complete it within the cost and time limit. He is also requested to send the progress of the work to the Government, every month, periodically.
