



## ABSTRACT

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### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued launching the Housing Scheme called Samathuvapuram by Government of Tamil Nadu in the year 1997-98 to promote the social justice and spread Thanthai Periyar's message of social equality. During the period from 1997 to 2001, 145 Samathuvapurams and during the period from 2008-2011, 93 Samathuvapurams totally 238 Samathuvapurams were established in rural areas of Tamil Nadu in which all the communities live with unity and brotherhood and share all basic infrastructure and the amenities without any discrimination.

2. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following Announcement on the Floor of Legislative Assembly on 24.06.2021, while replying to the debate on Governor's Address:-

“ஏற்றத்தாழ்வை இடித்து, சமூகத்தை சமப்படுத்த போராடிய தந்தை பெரியார் பெயரால் 240 சமத்துவபுரங்களை கட்டினார் முத்தமிழறிஞர் தலைவர் கலைஞர் அவர்கள், அந்த சமத்துவபுரங்கள் சரியாக பராமரிக்கப்படாத அவல நிலையில் இப்போது இருக்கின்றன. அந்த சமத்துவபுரங்கள் உடனடியாக சீரமைக்கப்படும்”.

3. Further, in continuation to the above Announcement, on 24.08.2021 the Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development has made the following Announcement:-

“24.06.2021 அன்று நடைபெற்ற ஆளுநர் உரை மீதான விவாதத்திற்கு பதில் அளிக்கும் போது, மாண்புமிகு முதலமைச்சர் அவர்கள் ஏற்கனவே கட்டப்பட்டுள்ள சமத்துவபுரங்கள் சீரமைக்கப்படும் என அறிவித்ததன் தொடர்ச்சியாக, ஏற்கனவே கட்டப்பட்டுள்ள பழைய சமத்துவபுரங்களை சீரமைப்பதற்காக, பழைய வீடுகளை பழுதுபார்த்தல், குடிநீர் விநியோகப் பணிகள், தெருவிளக்கு பராமரிப்பு, விளையாட்டு மைதானம், பூங்கா பராமரிப்பு, தந்தை பெரியாரின் சிலை பராமரிப்பு போன்ற பராமரிப்புப் பணிகள் படிப்படியாக மேற்கொள்ளப்படும்”.

4. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued according financial sanction and releasing fund for repair/reconstruction of 14,880 Houses in 149 old Samathuvapurams in Phase-I during the year 2021-2022 as per the Announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and Hon'ble Minister for Rural Development on the Floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 24.06.2021 and 24.08.2021 along with the detailed Guidelines.

5. In the letter read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent a proposal to Government, stating that the present condition of remaining Samathuvapurams have been surveyed by the District officials to renovate. Based on the survey detailed proposals for the renovation of 88 Samathuvapurams along with estimates have been received from the Districts as follows:-

**a) Repair/reconstruction of houses:**

Out of 8750 houses in 88 samathuvapurams (only 50 houses were constructed in Kuthalam Block of Mayiladuthurai district) 1116 houses were reported by the district officials as ineligible beneficiaries due to various reasons such as:

- i. Size of the house modified significantly
- ii. Government servants
- iii. Good condition houses
- iv. Beneficiary owns another pucca house
- v. Sold out to different category
- vi. Rented the house for monetary benefit etc.,

The occupancy status of the balance 7634 eligible houses proposed for renovation is as given below:-

Out of 7634 houses, it is proposed to take up minor repairs for 7574 houses as per actual estimated cost (cost ranging between Rs.26,200/- to Rs.89,700/-) depending on the nature of repairs required and 60 houses are proposed for reconstruction as per actual estimated cost (at an average cost ranging between Rs.2,10,000/- to Rs.5,60,000/- based on the stage from which reconstruction is proposed).

#### **Mode of Execution**

The mode of execution and funds required for repair/reconstruction of houses are as given below:

The abandoned / unallotted houses will be allotted to fresh beneficiaries following the Samathuvapuram Guidelines for selection of beneficiaries issued G.O. (Ms) No.44, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (SGS-1) Department, dated 28.03.2022. The identification of beneficiary and allotment will be done before the repair works are started by the Department.

In cases of all reconstruction works, the beneficiary will be instructed to make alternate arrangements for their stay as being done in Renovation of Samathuvapuram Phase-I till the repairs to houses are completed. Consent will be obtained from the beneficiaries in a prescribed format.

Residential Welfare Association has to be formed in each Samathuvapuram and registration certificate has to be submitted. This Association will monitor the quality of the work executed.

In case of all contract works, payment to the contractor will be released after getting the signature of the beneficiary in the prescribed form for satisfactory completion of the repair works.

**b) Repair to Other common infrastructures:**

The repairs to other common infrastructure works in 88 Samathuvapurams is proposed to be taken up with financial outlay of Rs.2733.041 Lakh in Phase-II during 2022-23.

The details of other common infrastructure work and funds required are as given below:

6. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary orders to repair / reconstruction of 88 old Samathuvapurams with the total financial outlay of Rs.6700.808 lakh during the year 2022-23 as Phase-II by sending the draft Guidelines in English.

7. The Government have carefully examined the above proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in detail and decided to accept the same and issue the following orders:-

- (i) Administrative sanction is accorded to the tune of Rs.67,00,80,800/- (Rupees Sixty seven crore eighty thousand and eight hundred only) and sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.36,71,71,500/- (Rupees Thirty six crore seventy one lakh seventy one thousand and five hundred only) for carrying out minor repair works in 7431 occupied houses as per actual estimated cost and to permit these works to be carried out by the concerned beneficiaries themselves.
- (ii) sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.89,19,200/- (Rupees Eighty nine lakh nineteen thousand and two hundred only) for carrying out minor repair works in 143 abandoned/ unallotted houses and Rs.2,06,86,000/- (Rupees Two crore six lakh eighty six thousand only) for reconstruction of 60 houses. Permission is accorded for repair/reconstruction of 203 (143+60) houses (occupied/ abandoned/unallotted) at a total cost of Rs.2,96,05,200/- (Rupees Two crore ninety six lakh five thousand and two hundred only) through Contract mode by the concerned Block Development Officer (Block Panchayat).
- (iii) Permission is accorded to carry out Repairs of other common infrastructure works at a total cost of Rs.27,33,04,100/- (Rupees Twenty seven crore thirty three lakh four thousand and hundred only) for 650 works through Contract mode by the concerned Block Development Officer (Block Panchayat).
- (iv) The road component of Rs.22,68,05,500/- shall be met out from Capital Grant Fund as per the 6<sup>th</sup> State Finance Commission recommendation.
- (v) Detailed Guidelines for repair/reconstruction of 88 old Samathuvapurams for the year 2022-23 in Phase-II is annexed to this order as Annexure-I and the details of repair/reconstruction works in 88 old Samathuvapurams taken up for the year 2022-23 are annexed to this order as Annexure-II to Annexure-VI.

8. The amount sanctioned in para 7 above should be debited to the following head of account:-

2216 – Housing – 03 – Rural Housing – 800 – Other expenditure State's expenditure – JJ – Reconstruction and Repairs of Samathuvapurams – 309 – Grants in aid – 03 – Grants for specific schemes.

9. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is permitted to utilize the amount sanctioned in para 7(i) and (ii) above and disburse the same to the Districts (except Chennai) and send the progress report on the renovation of old Samathuvapurams during the year 2022-2023, to the Government.

**ANNEXURE-I**

**GUIDELINES FOR REPAIR/ RECONSTRUCTION WORKS IN 88 OLD**  
**SAMATHUVAPURAMS UNDER PHASE-II FOR THE YEAR 2022-23**

**1. Introduction**

The Government of Tamil Nadu had launched the "Periyar Ninaivu Samathuvapuram" in rural areas in the year 1997-98 to promote social justice and spread Thanthai Periyar's message of Social equality. Under the scheme, construction of houses and also provision of other civic infrastructure in the habitations were carried out and the houses were allotted among the beneficiaries belonging to different communities. Totally, 238 Samathuvapurams were constructed in two spells, i.e. from 1997-2001 and 2008-2011. Out of this, 5 Samathuvapurams are yet to be allotted to beneficiaries. These Samathuvapurams have not been renovated since their establishment and considering their present status, the Government intends to renovate all Samathuvapurams constructed by Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department.

The renovation of Samathuvapurams will be taken up in a phased manner:

- a) In Phase-I, 145 Samathuvapurams constructed during 1997-2001 and 4 unallotted Samathuvapurams constructed during 2008-2011 were taken up for renovation in the year 2021-22.
- b) In Phase-II, remaining 88 Samathuvapurams constructed during 2008-2011 will be taken up for renovation during the year 2022-23.

**2. Objective**

The objective of the scheme is to renovate all 238 Samathuvapurams including the 15 located in urban areas. This includes repair/reconstruction of houses and also maintenance of common infrastructure.

**3. Category of works**

**a) Repair/Reconstruction of Houses**

- (i) Structural Failure (Below Basement)
- (ii) Damaged Super Structure (Basement)
- (iii) Partly Damaged Super Structure (Sill/Lintel Level)
- (iv) Minor Repairs - Plastering, Relaying weathering course & Colour Washing and completion
- (v) General Maintenance - Colour Washing and completion

## **4. Allocation of Funds**

All repair/reconstruction works mentioned in para 3(a) will be taken up as per actual estimated cost.

## **5. Mode of Execution**

In case of minor repairs for houses occupied by beneficiaries, the works will be executed through the beneficiary themselves. The minor repairs for all abandoned/ unallotted houses and houses requiring reconstruction will be done by adopting due tender process.

## **6. Administrative Sanction**

Administrative sanction shall be accorded by the District Collector. The execution of the works shall be entrusted to the Block Development Officer (Block Panchayat).

## **7. Preliminary steps to be taken up before executing the renovation works**

- i) Guidelines issued for renovation of Sold out / Rented / Abandoned Samathuvapuram Houses vide G.O.(Ms) No.71, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (SGS.1) Department, Dated: 13.06.2022 and G.O.(Ms) No.100, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (SGS.1) Department, Dated: 06.09.2022 respectively should not be violated.
- ii) In case of abandoned/un-allotted houses, the eligible beneficiary shall be identified and allotment shall be made before repair works are carried out by the Department as per G.O.(Ms)No.44, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (SGS.1) Department, Dated: 28.03.2022.
- iii) In case of reconstruction works, beneficiaries shall be informed prior to commencement of construction for making alternate arrangements for their stay. Consent shall be obtained from the beneficiaries in this regard.
- iv) Payment to Contractor shall be released only after obtaining completion certificate from beneficiary.

## 8. Execution of works

- i) The Union Overseers, Assistant Engineers/Junior Engineers shall be responsible for the renovation of works and other technical aspects.
- ii) The Assistant Executive Engineers shall super check all the works.
- iii) The Project Director, DRDAs, Executive Engineers (RD) and Assistant Executive Engineers (RD) should frequently inspect the progress in the execution of works and ensure its timely completion.

The measurements of works shall be recorded by the Union overseer/Assistant Engineer and the Check Measurement shall be done by the concerned Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer (RD) as per G.O. (Ms.) No.111, Rural development and Panchayat Raj (PR-1) Department, Dated: 21.08.2018. The Executive Engineer (RD) shall super check the works as per the norms indicated in G.O. (Ms) No. 54, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (PR.1) Department, dated: 22.05.2014.

- iv) All the mandatory Quality control tests before, during and after execution of the works must be done.
- v) The Block Development Officer(BP), shall call for the tenders for the following works in a Samathuvapuram as a single package to ensure uniformity in implementation,
  1. Minor repair to abandoned / unallotted houses
  2. Reconstruction of houses (Occupied/Abandoned)
  3. Repairs to other common infrastructure works

After execution of works the BDO (Block Panchayat) concerned shall make payment to the beneficiaries/ contractor. In case of houses executed through contract, payment shall be made to the contractor only after obtaining certificate from the beneficiary concerned for the satisfactory completion of works.

## 9. Monitoring

- i) The District Collector shall review the progress of the renovation works with the Block Officials at regular interval in order to ensure continuous monitoring and for expeditious completion of works.
- ii) The District Collector and Additional Collectors (Dev.,)/ Project Director, District Rural Development Agency are the Officers responsible for the proper implementation of the renovation works in Samathuvapurams at District Level.

## 10. Avenue Plantation

Raising of avenue plantations shall be done in all Samathuvapurams. Fruit bearing trees, shade trees, timber trees etc shall be planted along the roadside beyond the outer periphery of the berms so as to avoid cutting of trees in future during widening/improvement of roads. Avenue Plantation shall be done as per IRC-SP-103-2014 (Guidelines for Tree Plantation along Rural Roads) under General Fund or

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) or in co-ordination with the Forest Department under the special scheme for massive tree plantation in non-forest areas.

### 11. Documentation

Proper documentation of the works should be done capturing various processes in the implementation of the scheme. Photographs of the site before undertaking the work, during execution of the work and after completion of the work should be taken and properly documented and to be submitted to the Directorate.

The Principal Secretary to Government, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department is empowered to modify the guidelines of renovation of Samathuvapurams Scheme, whenever necessary, in consultation with the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj.
