ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued according Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.702 Crore allocating fund of Rs.3 Crore per Constituency exclusive of one nominated MLA., along with detailed Guidelines for the implementation of Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme (MLACDS) for the year 2022-2023 and sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.351 Crore being 50% of Fund out of Budget Allocation of Rs.705 Crore for the implementation of Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme for the year 2022-2023.

2. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his letter read above has stated that as per the Government order read above, Rs.351 Crore (excluding nominated MLA) was released to all District Collectors (except Chennai) and also to the Commissioner of Greater Chennai Corporation for the year 2022-2023. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that as we are already in the last quarter of this financial year 2021-2022 and also for ensuring speedy implementation of this scheme in all the Assembly Constituencies, the balance 50% of the MLACDS fund for the year 2022-2023 has to be released. Hence, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the release of balance 50% of the fund amounting to Rs.351 crore out of the total allocation of Rs.702 crore under MLACDS for the year 2022-2023.

- 3. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in detail, decided to accept the same and sanction a sum of Rs.351,00,00,000 (Rupees Three Hundred and Fifty One Crore only) being balance 50% of fund out of Budget Allocation of Rs.705 Crore excluding one nominated MLA for the implementation of Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme for the year 2022-2023.
