**ORDER:**

In the letter second read above, Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.1410.67 lakhs as 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> installment as Central Share for the implementation of District Rural Development Agency Administration Scheme during 2017-18 in the ratio 60:40. Accordingly, the State Government released a sum of Rs.2351.11 lakhs (inclusive of Central Share of Rs.1410.67 lakhs + State Share of Rs.940.44 lakhs) during the year 2017-18 as follows:

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the sanction of Rs.3,26,53,333/- (Central Share Rs.1,95,92,000/-(60%) + State Share Rs.1,30,61,333/-(40%) towards additional installment for implementation of the District Rural Development Agency Administrative Scheme for the year 2017-18 to the 31 District Rural Development Agencies thereby authorizing the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to draw and disburse the amount to the Districts concerned.

4. After careful examination, the Government have accepted the proposal of Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.3,26,53,333/- (Rupees Three crore twentysix lakh fifty three thousand three hundred and thirty three only) (Central Share Rs.1,95,92,000/- (60%) + State Share Rs.1,30,61,333/-(40%) towards additional installment for implementation of the District Rural Development Agency Administrative Scheme for the year 2017-18 to the 31 District Rural Development Agencies as annexed to this Government Order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following head of account :

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to the District Rural Development Agency in 31 districts through ECS as per annexure attached to this Government Order.

The Project Director, District Rural Development Agencies of concerned District is instructed to adhere to the instructions concerned in the sanction order issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development and properly report the release details while sending the Utilization Certificate and in the claim proposal to Government of India.
