The Government implemented the directive of the National Disaster Management Authority vide Government Order read above.

- 2. Based on the requests from the industries for clarifying the list of industries that can be classified as continuous process industries, the Government after careful examination identified the following industries as continuous process industries:
  - i. Refineries
  - ii. Large Steel Plants (including TMT bar manufacturers)
  - iii. Large Cement Plants
  - iv. Continuous Process Chemical Industries including paints
  - v. Sugar Mills
  - vi. Fertilizers
  - vii. Float Glass Plants
  - viii. Large Foundries with Continuous process
    - ix. Tyre manufacturing plants
    - x. Large Paper Mills.

Further it is ordered to permit the skeletal staff for essential maintenance of all closed industrial units to ensure the safety of the machinery/installation.
