ORDER:-

In Government Order second read above, the procedure for installation of statues were issued based on the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India noted in the reference first read above.

2. In the Government Order third read above, orders were issued by the Government in which administrative sanction was accorded for the construction of commemoration pillar in the eve of the Diamond Jubilee year celebration of India's Independence at an estimated cost of Rs.1.95 crore.

3. The Engineer-in-Chief (Buildings) and Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department in the letter fifth read above, has stated that CMDA issued the Planning approval for the proposed beautification work in the Traffic Island at the junction of Kamarajar Salai and Swami Sivananda Salai by erecting a Pillar in commemoration of 75th year of Independence. The CMDA has also informed that the Public Works Department should obtain necessary clearance from the Revenue and Disaster Management Department as stipulated in para 8 of the G.O.(Ms) No.183, Revenue Department, dated 23.05.2017 before commencement of the work. He has requested the Government to obtain necessary Government Order from the Revenue and Disaster Management Department to commence the above construction work early.

4. The Greater Chennai Corporation in the letter fourth read above has stated that, they have inspected the site and was found suitable and permitted Public Works Department to carry out beautification work.

5. The District Collector, Chennai in the letter seventh read above has stated that based on the reports from the Member Secretary, CMDA, The Executive Engineer, Public Works Department, (Buildings and Construction Division) Chennai, Commissioner of Police, Greater Chennai Police and the Technical opinion from the Director, Highways Research Station, Chennai, No Objection Certificate is granted for the proposed beautification work in the traffic island at the junction of Kamarajar Salai and Swamy Sivananda Salai by erecting a pillar in the commemoration of 75th year of Independence.

6. The Commissioner of Police, Greater Chennai Police in the letter eighth read above has given 'No Objection' from Law and Order and traffic point of view for erecting a pillar at the junction of Kamarajar Salai-Swamy Sivananda Salai.

7. The Director, Highways Research Station in the letter ninth read above has offered the following technical opinion:-

- a) The Central oil drop island of size 22.10 X 21.85 X 6.00 m at the edge of Swamy Sivananda Salai is proposed to accommodate the proposed 75th Independence day Pillar such that the visibility of traffic shall not be affected.
- b) The triangular channelizing island of size 4.85 X 3.21 X 2.70 m is proposed to segregate the free left traffic and right turning traffic from Kamarajar Salai to Sivananda Salai followed by diagonal marking.

- c) Necessary pedestrian crossing in the Sivananda Salai shall be provided as per IRC 103:2012.
- d) Necessary road markings and road signages shall be provided at the junction as per IRC 35:2015 and IRC 67:2012.

8. The case was examined by the Government in detail in the light of the rules prevailing in force based on the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, Government orders read above, and the recommendations of the District Collector, Chennai, Member Secretary, CMDA, Commissioner of Police, Greater Chennai Police, the Director, Highways Research Station the Government hereby order to allow the Public Works Department for the construction of pillar to commemorate the 75th year of India's Independence in the junction of Kamarajar Salai and Swami Sivananda Salai in T.S.No.3174, Block No.60, Triplicane Village, Chennai subject to the condition that the said structure does not attract the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP (C) No.8519/2006, dated 18.01.2013 as ordered in G.O.(Ms) No.183, Revenue Department, dated 23.05.2017.

9. The District Collector, Chennai and the Engineer-in-Chief (Building) and Chief Engineer(Building) Chennai Region, Public Works Department are requested to take necessary further action as per the orders issued in para 8 above.
