## **ORDER:**

In the Government order first read above, the Government have sanctioned Rs.79.50 Crore for the purchase of Computers, Printers, UPS and for the provision of Broadband connectivity to 12,524 Village Panchayats for the implementation of e-Panchayat applications including PRIA Soft – Model Accounting System.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that as per orders issued in G.O. (Ms.) No.26, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (PR.1) Department, dated 12.04.2012 Computer, UPS and Printer have been installed in all the Village Panchayats and broadband connectivity has been given in 9,373 Village Panchayats so far. The ELCOT is imparting basic computer training to all the Village Panchayat Secretaries. To fulfill the objectives and monitorable targets set out in the Vision 2023 Document and to improve the service delivery to the public, the State Government have already taken action to establish Common Service Centres (CSCs) in the rural and urban areas. On these lines, it is proposed to provide service delivery to the public through the Common Service Centres established in the Village Panchayats also. Initially, it is proposed to start Common Service Centres in 100 Village Panchayat Offices on pilot basis. The Information Technology Department rolled out the following services through the Common Service

Centres already established in rural and urban areas may be delivered in the new centres also:

- a) E-payment of House Tax/Property Tax, Professional Tax and water charges.
- b) E-Payment of Electricity Bill / Telephone Bills by the rural people.
- c) Community / Nativity / Income Certificate.
- d) E-Booking of SETC Bus Tickets / IRCTC tickets.
- e) E-Services of Land Records offered by Revenue Department.
- f) E-Verification of Land Ownership offered by Registration Department.
- g) Online information about Agriculture extension and Marketing.
- h) Chief Minister's Girl Child Protection Scheme.
- i) Moovalur Ramamirtham Ammaiyur Ninaivu Marriage Assistance Scheme.
- j) Dr. Muthulakshmi Reddy Ninaivu Inter caste Marriage Assistance Scheme.
- k) Daily prices of Agricultural commodities.
- l) Cut-off Seniority dates adopted for nomination in Employment Offices.
- m) Backward Classes, Most Backward Classes and Minorities Welfare Scholarship Status.
- n) Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Scholarship Status.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that for the establishment of Common Service Centres, the facilities such as sufficient space, computer with the peripherals and broadband connectivity available at the Village Panchayats will be utilized. As discussed in the meeting held on 22.01.2014, the Information Technology Department will provide manpower to run the Common Service Centres to be established at the Village Panchayat Offices. Similarly, the software applications developed for the Common Service Centres will be given by the Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency. In respect of collection and utilization of service charges, the existing guidelines issued by the Information Technology Department may be followed for the Common Service Centres to be established at the Village Panchayat offices also.

4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the establishment of 100 Common Service Centres in Village Panchayats in 15 districts of Tamil Nadu.

5. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, establish 100 Common Service Centres in Village Panchayat in 15 Districts of Tamil Nadu as detailed in annexure to this order. The Government also direct the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (i/c) to verify with the Managing Director, ELCOT on the following points:

- (i) Maintenance of Infrastructure
- (ii) Revenue sharing by the Service Provider
