

## **ABSTRACT**

Centrally Sponsored Schemes – Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana(Gramin) (erstwhile Indira Awaas Yojana) - Release of State additional fund for RCC roofing cost of Rs.38,85,00,000/- towards the residual allotment of 7,770 houses under Indira Awaas Yojana 2015-16 – Sanction accorded – Orders – Issued.

## ORDER:

In the letter third read above the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that Government of India originally allotted 53,429 houses under Indira Awaas Yojana 2015-16 under a funding pattern of 50:50 between Central and State. Subsequently, the fund sharing pattern of Central and State has been revised as 60:40 instead of 50:50 and the physical target was reduced by Government of India to 45,044 houses. In the meantime, based on the original target of 53,429 houses, the sub allocation to the districts was done by the State, beneficiaries were identified and works have commenced in the field, before the revised target of 45,044 houses was communicated; the Government of India also released a sum of Rs.19675.219 lakhs including 4% Administrative cost as Central Share for the revised target of 45,044 houses. Accordingly, the corresponding State Share of Rs.35638.813 lakhs was released including 4% Administrative cost and RCC roofing cost. Since the works have been commenced in the field for all 53,429 houses, the Government of India has been addressed to sanction the entire share for 8,385 houses (53,429-45,044) which are left out including the administrative cost. The Government of India based on the request, has revised target to 52,814 houses for the year 2015-16 instead of the original allocation of 53429 houses and also sanctioned a sum of Rs.33,93,94,000/- towards Central Share including administrative cost towards the residual allotment of 7,770 2015-16. houses under IAY

- 2. In the Government Order first and second read above, Government have accorded sanction a sum of Rs.56,56,56,000/- (Rs.33,93,94,000/- Central Share + Rs.22,62,62,000/- State Share) excluding the roofing cost towards the residual allotment of 7,770 houses under IAY for the year 2015-16. The above said amount was drawn and released to beneficiaries through PFMS Account in proportion to the progress.
- 3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that as per Awaas Soft report dated 11.07.2017 under IAY 2015-16, 1<sup>st</sup> installment was paid to 53,100 beneficiaries, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment was paid to 52,670 beneficiaries, 3<sup>rd</sup> installment was paid to 51,662 beneficiaries and 4<sup>th</sup> installment was released to 48,078 beneficiaries. Further, most of the houses taken up under IAY 2015-16 have already been completed and certain houses have been physically completed but the payment are pending due to paucity of the funds.
- 4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction for a sum of Rs.38,85,00,000/- as State Additional Fund for RCC Roofing cost towards the residual allocation of 7,770 houses under Indira Awaas Yojana 2015-16, so that payment to all beneficiaries can be made based on the actual progress of the houses.
- 5. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.38,85,00,000/(Rupees Thirty eight crore eighty five lakh only) as State additional fund for RCC Roofing Cost towards the residual allocation of 7770 houses under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana 2015-16.
