## ORDER:

National Rurban Mission(NRuM) aims at developing cluster of Villages with facilities perceived to be essentially urban in nature, thus creating "Rurban Villages". The objective of the National Rurban Mission(NRuM) is to stimulate local economic development, enhance basic services and create well planned Rurban clusters and Government of India approved 5 clusters under Phase-I (2016-2019) and 3 clusters

under Phase-II (2017-2020) of Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission(SPMRM) in respect of Tamil Nadu as detailed below:

2. The National Level Empowered Committee under Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission has approved the Integrated Cluster Action Plans(ICAPs) for Phase-I and Phase-II Districts with the following Critical Gap Funding:-

As per SPMRM guidelines, the allocation of Critical Gap Fund(CGF) is shared between the Government of India and the State Government in the ratio of 60:40. According to the funding pattern approved by the Empowered Committee, CGF amount will be released in three installments, i.e 1<sup>st</sup> installment – 30% amount, 2<sup>nd</sup> installment – 40% amount. So far, the Government released 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> installment CGF amount for a sum of Rs.90.00 crore for Phase-I Clusters and a sum of Rs.54.00 crore for Phase-II clusters.

3. In the Government Order first read above, the Government released a sum of Rs.45.00 crore [Rs.27.00 crore as Central share(60%) + Rs.18.00 crore as State share(40%)] as 1st installment of Critical Gap Fund for 5 clusters of Phase-I Districts year 2016-17 under **National** Rurban Mission. the Government Order second read above, the Government released

sum of Rs.45.00 crore [Rs.27.00 crore as Central share(60%) + Rs.18.00 crore as State share(40%)] as 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of Critical Gap Fund for 5 clusters of Phase-I Districts for the year 2017-18 under National Rurban Mission.

- 4. In the Government Order third read above, the Government released a sum of Rs.27.00 crore [Rs.16.20 crore as Central share(60%) + Rs.10.80 crore as State share(40%)] as 1<sup>st</sup> installment of Critical Gap Fund for 3 clusters of Phase-II Districts for the year 2017-18 under National Rurban Mission. In the Government Order fourth read above, the Government released a sum of Rs.27.00 crore [Rs.16.20 crore as Central share(60%) + Rs.10.80 crore as State share(40%)] as 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of Critical Gap Fund for 3 clusters of Phase-II Districts for the year 2018-19 under National Rurban Mission.
- 5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his letter seventh read above, has stated that utilization certificates for 5 Clusters in Phase-I and 3 Clusters in Phase-II have been sent to Government of India requesting to release of 3<sup>rd</sup> installment fund.
- 6. In the letter fifth and sixth read above, the Government of India released a sum of Rs.28,80,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Eight Crore and Eighty Lakh only) as Central Share of first tranche of 3<sup>rd</sup> installment to the State Government for Phase-I and Phase-II Clusters. As such, an amount of Rs.28,80,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Eight Crore and Eighty Lakh only) along with Rs.19,20,00,000/- (Rupees Nineteen Crore and Twenty Lakh only) is to be transferred towards State matching share to the account of State Nodal Agency for the purpose of utilization of funds for Phase-I and Phase-II Clusters.

  - (ii) The amount sanctioned above may be debited to the following head of account:

- (ii) To authorize the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to draw the sanctioned amount from the above Head of account and maintain the funds in the account of State Nodal Agency for the purpose of utilization of funds through PFMS for Phase-I and Phase-II Clusters under Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission for the year 2020-21.
- 8. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj have decided to accept the same and accordingly, the Government further release a sum of Rs.48.00 crore [Rs.28.80 crore as Central share (60%) and Rs.19.20 crore as State Share (40%)] towards first tranche of 3<sup>rd</sup> installment of Critical Gap Fund(CGF) to the account of State Nodal Agency for the purpose of utilization of funds for Phase-I and Phase-II Clusters under SPMRM for the year 2020-21.
