Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme – Announcement made by Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 19.3.2020 – Construction of 25,000 Cattle and Goat Shelters at a total cost of Rs.431 crore under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme for the year 2020-21 – Administrative Sanction accorded – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

The Honourable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following announcements under Rule 110 on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 19.03.2020:

“ஊரகப்பகுதிகளில் உள்ள கால்நடைகளை பாதுகாத்திட 2020-21 ஆம் நிதியாண்டில் 9 ஆயிரம் மாட்டுக் கொட்டகைகளும், 6 ஆயிரம் ஆட்டுக் கொட்டகைகளும் என மொத்தம் 15 ஆயிரம் கால்நடை கொட்டகைகள் 258.60 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் கட்டித் தரப்படும்”.

“ஆதிதிராவிடர் குடியிருப்புப் பகுதிகளில் அனைத்து அடிப்படை வசதிகளையும் மேம்படுத்திட வேண்டும் என்ற உயரிய நோக்கில், பல்வேறு திட்டங்களை ஒருங்கிணைத்து உரிய நிதி ஒதுக்கீடு செய்து, அதனை செயல்படுத்தும் விதத்தில், 2020-21ஆம் ஆண்டைய நிதிநிலை அறிக்கையில் வழிவகை செய்யப்பட்டுள்ளது. அதன்படி, மகாத்மா காந்தி தேசிய ஊரக வேலை உறுதியளிப்புத் திட்டம், மத்திய, மாநில நிதிக் குழுவின் நிதி மற்றும் அம்மா ஆதிதிராவிடர் குடியிருப்பு மேம்பாட்டு திட்ட நிதி ஆகியவற்றில் இருந்து 2,500 கோடி ரூபாய் ஒதுக்கீடு செய்யப்படும். இந்நிதியில் இருந்து, ஆதிதிராவிடர் குடியிருப்பு பகுதிகளில் குடிநீர் வசதி, இணைப்புச் சாலை வசதி, சிமெண்ட் / பேவர் பிளாக் சாலை வசதி, தெரு விளக்குகள், வடிகால் வசதி, மயான மேம்பாடு உள்ளிட்ட அடிப்படை வசதிகள் ஏற்படுத்தப்படும் என்பதை மகிழ்ச்சியுடன் இப்பேரவைக்கு தெரிவித்துக் கொள்கிறேன்”.

2. Based on the above announcements, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent a proposal stating that in the Revised Schedule-I of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005,

Sl.No. II. Category B: Community Assets Or Individual Assets: "New Individual Assets for Vulnerable Section, (v), creation of infra-structure facilities for promotion of live stock, such as poultry shelter, goat shelter, piggery shelter, cattle shelter and fodder trough for cattle" are permissible under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme. The construction of Cattle / Goat / Poultry Shelters for Individuals is a permissible activity as per Sl. No 211, 212 and 214 of the list of permissible works under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act. Accordingly, it is proposed to construct 15000 cattle shelters of which, 10000 Nos. of 2 cows shelter at an unit cost of Rs.1.35 lakhs and 5000 Nos. of 5 cows shelter at an unit cost of Rs.2.12 lakhs. Like wise, 10000 Goat Shelters of which, 5000 Nos. of 10 Goats shelter at an unit cost of Rs.1.53 lakhs and 5000 Nos. of 20 Goats shelter at an unit cost of Rs.2.27 lakhs under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme during the year 2020-21 to protect the Cattles, Goats of beneficiaries provided from priceless Cow and Goat Scheme, Self Help Group Women farmers, Small and Marginal Farmers and for the farmers who come under the vulnerable category as mentioned in para 5 of Schedule I. The total cost will be Rs.431.00 crore. Out of 15000 cattle shelters, 6000 cattle shelters of which 4000 Nos. of 2 Cows shelter and 2000 Nos of 5 Cows shelter and out of 10000 Goat shelters, 4000 cattle shelters of which 2000 Nos. of 10 Goats shelter and 2000 Nos. of 20 Goats shelter shall be allocated to SC Beneficiaries. i.e 40% of work shall be allocated to SC Beneficiaries.

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the above work has been proposed in the Labour Budget for the Financial Year 2020-21 and the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has approved Labour Budget of 27 crore person days under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme to Tamil Nadu for the financial year 2020-21. The Government of India have notified the wage rate for the Financial Year 2020-21 as Rs.256/- per day in respect of Tamil Nadu. Accordingly, the wage rate for the year 2020-21 approved in G.O.Ms.No.82, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 30.03.2020 and Rural Schedule of Rates approved in G.O.Ms.No.86, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 13.04.2020 shall be adopted. The detailed guidelines issued vide G.O.(Ms.)No.126, RD & PR (CGS.1)Department, Dated 10.09.2019 shall be adopted and referred for planning, execution of construction of Cattle and Goat Shelters and Non Negotiable items without any change. In addition to this the following guidelines shall also be adopted.

Selection Criteria:

- 40% Work shall be allocated to SC Beneficiaries. i.e Out of 15000 cattle shelters, 6000 cattle shelters of which 4000 Nos.of 2 cows shelter and 2000 Nos. of 5 cows shelter and out of 10000 Goat shelters, 4000 cattle shelters of which 2000

Nos. of 10 Goats shelter and 2000 Nos. of 20 Goats shelter shall be allocated to SC Beneficiaries.

- The Project Director (DRDA) shall use the THAI survey report as the basic data and identify the requirement of all the SC inhabited areas in the district through the Block Development Officer (BP) concerned.
- The Project Director (DRDA) shall prioritize and prepare the list of SC habitations to be covered under this scheme in a particular year based on descending order of SC population in the district. i.e Selection of beneficiaries shall be based on the Grama Shaba Resolution of the Village Panchayat concerned.
- **“Atrocity prone villages”** identified by Additional Director General of Police, Social Justice and Human **Rights should compulsorily be taken up, irrespective of the population.**
- Only after exhausting the requirement of atrocity prone villages in the blocks of the districts, the other Adi Dravidar habitations shall be selected, based on descending order of population.
- The other beneficiaries shall be Small Farmer / Marginal Farmer or any other vulnerable category as mentioned in Para 5 of Schedule I.
- Resolution shall be obtained in Grama Sabha for all the beneficiaries community wise and beneficiary wise selection list shall be entered in Register No.2.

Non-Negotiable Items:

- In case of works taken up in Adi dravidar habitations, the logo and emblem shall be done on one side of MGNREGS Citizen Information Board painting as per G.O.(Ms) No.190, RD & PR (PR.3) dated 31.12.2019 at an additional cost of **Rs.500** for acrylic painting and logo/emblem tiles. The cost of the information board shall be included in the estimate itself to the tune of **Rs.1,350/-** (i.e., Rs.850/- for MGNREGS Citizen Information Board and Rs.500/- for logo and emblem) for works taken-up in the Adi dravidar habitations, and for SC beneficiaries.
- Estimate creation, Administrative sanction and Technical sanction shall be done in SECURE software.

4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the labour and material component details for construction of Cattle and Goat (for 2 cattle, 5 cattle, 10 Goat, 20 Goat) are as below. The Labour cost is borne 100% by the Government of India and the material cost is shared in the ratio of 75:25 by the Government of India and the State Government:-

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction for the 15000 cattle shelters of which, 10000 Nos. of 2 cows shelter at an unit cost of Rs.1.35 lakhs and 5000 Nos. of 5 cows shelter at an unit cost of Rs.2.12 lakhs. Like wise, 10000 Goat Shelters of which, 5000 Nos. of 10 Goats shelter at an unit cost of Rs.1.53 lakhs and 5000 Nos. of 20 Goats shelter at an unit cost of Rs.2.27 lakhs under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme during the year 2020-21 and to adopt the detailed guidelines issued in respect of construction of Cattle and Goat shelters for the year 2019-2020 vide G.O.(MS). No.126, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department (CGS-1), dated 10.09.2019.

6. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj and accord Administrative Sanction for construction of 15000 cattle shelters of which, 10000 Nos. of 2 cows shelter at an unit cost of Rs.1.35 lakhs and 5000 Nos. of 5 cows shelter at an unit cost of Rs.2.12 lakhs. And also for construction of 10000 Goat Shelters of which, 5000 Nos. of 10 Goats shelter at an unit cost of Rs.1.53 lakhs and 5000 Nos. of 20 Goats shelter at an unit cost of Rs.2.27 lakhs under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme during the year 2020-21 by adopting the detailed guidelines issued vide G.O.(MS). No.126, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department (CGS-1), dated 10.09.2019 in respect of construction of Cattle and Goat Shelters for the year 2019-20, subject to the condition that the Financial sanction shall be made only after receipt of Government of India share.

6. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.39319/RD/20 dated 03.11.2020.
