Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme – Announcement made by Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 19.3.2020 – Construction of Individual and Community Soak Pits at a cost of Rs.200.41 crores under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme in Rural Areas during the year 2020-21 – Administrative Sanction accorded – Orders – Issued.

#### ORDER:

The Honourable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following Announcement under Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rule 110 on 19.03.2020:

''ஆதிதிராவிடா் குடியிருப்புப் பகுதிகளில் அனைத்து அடிப்படை வசதிகளையும் வேண்டும் என்ற உயரிய நோக்கில், <u>பல்வேறு</u> திட்டங்களை மேம்படுத்திட ஒருங்கிணைத்து உரிய நிதி ஒதுக்கீடு செய்து, அதனை செயல்படுத்தும் விதத்தில், 2020–21 ஆம் ஆண்டைய நிதிநிலை அறிக்கையில் வழிவகை செய்யப்பட்டுள்ளது. அதன்படி, மகாத்மா காந்தி தேசிய ஊரக வேலை உறுதியளிப்புத் திட்டம், மத்திய, மாநில நிதிக்குழுவின் நிதி மற்றும் அம்மா ஆதிதிராவிடர் குடியிருப்பு மேம்பாட்டு திட்ட நிதி ஆகியவற்றில் இருந்து 2,500 கோடி ரூபாய் ஒதுக்கீடு செய்யப்படும். இந்நிதியில் இருந்து, ஆதிதிராவிடர் குடியிருப்பு பகுதிகளில் குடிநீர் வசதி, இணைப்புச் சாலை வசதி, சிமெண்ட் / பேவர் பிளாக் சாலை வசதி, தெருவிளக்குகள், வடிகால் வசதி, மயான மேம்பாடு உள்ளிட்ட அடிப்படை வசதிகள் ஏற்படுத்தப்படும் என்பதை மகிழ்ச்சியுடன் இப்பேரவைக்கு தெரிவித்துக் கொள்கிறேன்".

2. Further, the Hon'ble Minister for Municipal Administration, Rural Development and Implementation of Special Programmes has made the following Announcement on 16.03.2020:

''ஊரகப் பகுதிகளில் சுற்றுச்சூழல் மற்றும் சுகாதாரத்தினை மேம்படுத்திடவும், குடியிருப்பு பகுதிகளில் உள்ள சாலைகள் மற்றும் தெருக்களில் திரவக் கழிவுகள் தேங்கி நோய் தொற்று ஏற்படாது பாதுகாத்திடவும், **மாண்புமிகு இதயதெய்வம் புரட்சித் தலைவி** அம்மா அவர்களின் ஆசியுடன், மாண்புமிகு தமிழ்நாடு முதலமைச்சர் அவர்களின் ஆணைப்படி, 2020–21 ஆம் நிதியாண்டில், தமிழகத்தில் அனைத்து ஊராட்சிகளிலும் 1,45,000 தனிநபர் உறிஞ்சு குழிகள் மற்றும் 17,850 சமுதாய உறிஞ்சு குழிகள், ஆக மொத்தம் 1 இலட்சத்து 62 ஆயிரத்து 850 உறிஞ்சு குழிகள் 161 கோடியே 20 இலட்சம் ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் அமைக்கப்படும்".

- 3. Based on the above announcements the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent a proposal stating that the Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development has approved Labour Budget of 27 crore person days under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme to Tamil Nadu for the financial year 2020-21. Effective management of grey water in rural areas at household level is very much necessary and waste water/grey water generated at household level should be managed at the source so that zero or minimum community waste is generated in the rural areas, as part of liquid waste management.
- 4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that, it is proposed to construct 2,00,500 Soakpits including 1,75,000 Individual Soakpits, 25,000 Community-Type 1 Soakpits, 100 Community (Cluster / Habitation) Horizontal Filter-Type 2 Soakpits and 400 Community (Cluster / Habitation) Vertical Filter-Type 3 Soakpits during the Financial Year 2020-21 under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme. As per the announcements made by Hon'ble Chief Minister under Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rule 110 above, target for Adi Dravidar habitations are allocated exclusively as detailed below:-

The above works have been proposed in the Labour Budget for the Financial Year 2020-21 and the same was approved by the Empowered Committee, Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India during the Empowered committee Meeting held on 13.03.2020. The Annual Master Circular 2019-20 - Para 7.9. 'Solid Waste Management (SWM) under MGNREGS', states that, "Paragraph 4(1) (iv) (i) of

Schedule-I of the MGNREGA, provides for rural sanitation works under Rural Infrastructure Category, wherein solid and liquid waste management works (SLWM) may be undertaken amongst other listed works. Accordingly, works like construction of soak pits may be undertaken under MGNREGS as standalone works." In the "Permissible Works List" communicated by MoRD, GoI, Construction of Soak Pits for Individual and Community have been listed at SI.No. 224 and 225 respectively, under the category of "D" Assets".

5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the Government of India have notified the wage rate for the FY 2020-21 as Rs.256/- per day in respect of Tamil Nadu. Accordingly the revision of wage rate, the Rural Schedule of Rate (RSoR) was approved for the Financial Year 2020-21 in G.O.Ms.No.82, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 30.03.2020 and G.O (Ms). No.86 RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated:13.04.2020 respectively and the Rural Schedule of Rate 2020-21 is adopted for this work. The detailed guidelines issued vide G.O.(MS). No.124, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department (CGS-1), dated 12.09.2018 with regard to construction of soakpits issued for FY 2018-19, shall be adopted for the year 2020-21 also and referred for Planning, selection of work, execution of Individual and three types of Community Soak Pits and Non Negotiable items without any deviation.

#### **Work Selection in Adi Dravidar Habitations:**

- The Project Director (DRDA) should use the THAI survey report as the basic data and identify the requirement of all the SC inhabited areas in the district through the Block Development Officer (BP) concerned.
- The Project Director (DRDA) should prioritize and prepare the list of SC habitations to be covered under this scheme in a particular year based on descending order of SC population in the district.
- Selection of sites shall be based on descending order of population.
- "Atrocity prone villages" identified by Additional Director General of Police, Social Justice and Human Rights should compulsorily be taken up, irrespective of the population.
- Only after exhausting the requirement of atrocity prone villages in the blocks of the districts, the works in other Adi Dravidar habitations should be undertaken, based on descending order of population.

### Non-Negotiable Items:

- 1. Wherever the work is taken-up in the Adi dravidar habitations, the logo and emblem as per G.O.(Ms) No.190, RD & PR (PR.3) dated 31.12.2019 shall be done on the either side or nearby the MGNREGS Citizen Information Board, as the case may be, at an additional cost of Rs.500 for acrylic painting and logo/emblem tiles. The cost of the information board shall be included in the estimate itself.
- 2. Estimate creation, Administrative sanction and Technical sanction shall be done in SECURE software.
- 3. The Notified Wage Rate as per G.O. Ms.No.82, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 30.03.2020 and the Rural Schedule of Rates finalised in G.O. Ms. No.86, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 13.04.2020 shall be adopted. In case of any revision made in Rural Schedule of Rates in future, the same shall be adopted.

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the Unit Cost, Labour Material Component, Labour Material Ratio and Mandays to be generated for the Construction of 1,75,000 Nos. of individual Household soak pits, 25,000 Nos. of Type 1Community Soak Pits (at Public Fountain, Hand Pump, OHT etc.,), 100 Nos. of Type 2 Community Soak Pit - Horizontal filter and 400 Nos. of Type 3 Community Soak Pit - Vertical filter based on the model estimates are detailed below. The unit cost is calculated based on the Standard type design and Rural Schedule of Rates for the year 2020-21 as follows. However, the actual estimate may vary according to the site condition.

The Labour cost is borne 100% by the Government of India and the material cost is shared at the ratio of 75:25 by the Gol and the State Government and the detailed funding pattern is as follows:-

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested that the Government to accord permission for the construction of 1,75,000 Nos. of individual Household Soak Pits, 25,000 Nos. of type 1 Community Soak Pits (at Public Fountain, Hand Pump, OHT etc.,),100 Nos. of Type 2 Community Soak Pit - Horizontal filter and 400 Nos. of Type 3 Community Soak Pit - Vertical filter at a total estimated cost of Rs.200.41 crores during the Financial Year 2020-21 under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme and to adopt the detailed guidelines already issued for construction of Soak Pits for 2018-19 vide

G.O.(Ms).No.124, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department (CGS-1), dated 12.09.2018.

- 8. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj and accord Administrative Sanction for the construction of 1,75,000 Nos. of individual Household Soak Pits, 25,000 Nos. of type 1 Community Soak Pits (at Public Fountain, Hand Pump, OHT etc.,), 100 Nos. of Type 2 Community Soak Pit Horizontal filter and 400 Nos. of Type 3 Community Soak Pit Vertical filter at a total estimated cost of Rs.200.41 crores in Rural Areas under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme during the Financial Year 2020-21 by adopting the detailed guidelines already issued for construction of Soak Pits vide G.O.(Ms).No.124, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department (CGS-1), dated 12.09.2018, subject to the condition that the Financial Sanction shall be made only after receipt of Government of India share.
- 7. This order is issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.39566/RD/20, dated: 07.11.2020.
