ORDER:

The Honourable Minister for Municipal Administration, Rural Development and Implementation of Special Programme has made the following announcement on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 16.03.2020:

“கூட்டுறவு பால் சங்கங்களுக்கு பால் சேகரிப்பதற்கு தேவையான உட்கட்டமைப்பு வசதிகளை ஏற்படுத்துவதற்காக 2020-21 ஆம் நிதியாண்டில் 200 பால் சேகரிக்கும் கூடங்கள் ஒவ்வொன்றும் 15 இலட்சத்து 27 ஆயிரம் ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் மொத்தம் 30 கோடியே 54 இலட்சம் ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் கட்டப்படும்”.

2. Based on the above announcement, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent a proposal stating that Para 7.7(c) of **Annual Master Circular 2019-20** of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme permits the construction of Milk Collection Centres for collection, storage, value addition and marketing for the benefit of the Milk Producers / Farmers in rural areas. Accordingly, it is proposed to construct 200 Milk Collection Centres at an unit cost of Rs.15.27 lakhs with a total cost of Rs.30.54 crores under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme during the year 2020-21 to improve the quality of milk and to provide the safe environment to milk collection. The above work has been proposed in the Labour Budget for the Financial Year 2020-21 and the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has approved Labour Budget of 27 crore persondays under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme to Tamil Nadu for the Financial Year 2020-21. The Government

of India have notified the wage rate for the Financial Year 2020-21 as Rs.256/- per day in respect of Tamil Nadu. Accordingly, the wage rate for the year 2020-21 approved in G.O.Ms. No.82, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 30.03.2020 and Rural Schedule of Rates approved in G.O.Ms.No.86, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated:13.04.2020 shall be adopted. In case of any revision made in Rural Schedule of Rates in future, the same shall be adopted. The detailed guidelines issued vide G.O.(Ms).No.122, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (CGS1) Department dated 12.09.2018 and G.O.(Ms).No.141, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (CGS1) Department dated 24.09.2019 regarding the construction of Milk Collection Centres shall be adopted and referred for Planning, selection of work, Type Design, Non Negotiable items and Technical Specification without any change. In addition to this, the following guidelines shall also be adopted.

Selection Criteria

- Site shall be selected with the Area of 1000 sq.ft minimum for the construction of Milk Collection Centre as the building requires 774 sq.ft and open space is required for Cattle Trough and Milking of Cows in and around the building.
- Resolution shall be obtained in Grama Sabha for all the selected works and it shall be entered work wise in Register No.2 of Mahatma Gandhi NREGA of the village Panchayat concerned.

Non-Negotiable Items:

- Estimate creation, Administrative sanction and Technical sanction shall be done in SECURE software.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the unit cost of Milk Collection Centre will be Rs.15.27 lakhs. The Labour cost is borne 100% by the Government of India and the material cost is shared at the ratio of 75:25 by the Government of India and the State Government. The fund requirement and the Central and State share for the construction of Milk Collection Centre is given below:

4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction for the construction of 200 Milk Collection Centres at a total cost of Rs.30.54 crores under Mahatma Gandhi National

Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme in Rural Areas during the year 2020-21 and also to adopt the guidelines issued vide G.O.(Ms) No.122, RD & PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated 12.09.2018 and G.O.(Ms) No.141, RD & PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated 24.09.2019 regarding the construction of Milk Collection Centres for the year 2018-19 and 2019-20.

5. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj and accord Administrative Sanction for the construction of 200 Milk Collection Centres at a total cost of Rs.30.54 crores under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme during the year 2020-21 by adopting the guidelines issued for construction of Milk Collection Centres vide G.O.(Ms.) No.141, RD & PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated 24.09.2019, subject to the condition that the Financial Sanction shall be made only after receipt of Government of India share.

6. This order is issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.39576/RD/20, dated : 07.11.2020.
