



## **ABSTRACT**

Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department – Grants – Award under Fifteenth Central Finance Commission – Balance amount of 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment of Basic Grant - Untied component Rs.548.48 crore to Rural Local Bodies for the year 2020-21 – Sanction – Orders – Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.901.75 crore towards 50% of basic grant untied component as first installment for the year 2020-2021.

2. In the Government Order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government have approved the Guidelines for the implementation of 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission grants to Rural Local Bodies.

3. In the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.353.27 Crore as Basic Grant-untied component towards the second installment of 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission grant for all three tiers of panchayats.

4. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Ministry of Finance, Government of India in its letter dated 12.05.2021 released a sum of Rs.548.48 crore as balance amount of second instalment of Basic Grant to Rural Local Bodies as recommended by the 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission for the year 2020-2021.

5. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that in Budget Estimate for the year 2021-22, the following provisions have been made under the head of accounts pertaining to 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission Grant for Rural Local Bodies for the year 2021-2022:-

6. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the Fifteenth Central Finance Commission has recommended that the Grants for Rural Local Bodies (RLBs) are in two parts, namely, Basic and Tied Grants, in the ratio of 50:50. Now, this release of balance amount of second instalment of Basic Grant for the year 2020-2021 is untied and can be used by Rural Local Bodies for location-specific felt needs, except for salary or other established expenditure.

The Fifteenth Central Finance Commission has also recommended that its Grant, Basic and Tied, should be distributed to all the tiers of the Panchayats in the states on the basis of the accepted recommendation of the latest State Finance Commission (SFC) and also in conformity to the bands recommended by XV FC.

In this context, the following sharing/ Distribution formula have been approved by the Government in respect Rural Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu.

- The vertical sharing ratio among three tiers of Rural Local Bodies will be 5:15:80 for District Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and Village Panchayats respectively.
- Horizontal Distribution of Fifteenth Finance Commission Grant within the tier will be as per the Horizontal Distribution formula as recommended by Fifth State Finance Commission formula given below:
  - a) Population as per 2011 census : 60%
  - b) Area : 15%
  - c) SC/ST population : 15%
  - d) Per capita consumption  
Expenditure Distance : 10%

7. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to issue orders for the sanction and release of a total sum of **Rs. 548.48 Crore** (Rupees Five Hundred and forty eight crore and forty eight lakh only) towards balance amount of Basic (Untied) Grant for 12,525 Village Panchayats and 388 Panchayat Unions and 36 District Panchayats and also requested to authorize the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to draw and disburse the amount to the three tiers of Panchayat Raj Institutions.

8. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj accord sanction for sum of **Rs. 548,48,00,000/-** (Rupees Five Hundred and forty eight crore and forty eight lakh only) towards balance amount of Basic (Untied) Grant under Fifteenth Central Finance Commission to Rural Local Bodies for the year 2020-2021.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 8 above shall be debited to the following Head of Accounts:-

However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative (by Specific Inclusion) in the Supplementary Estimates 2021-22. Pending provision of such funds, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 8 above. He is directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RBE/RE/FMA 2021-2022 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the supplementary Estimates 2021-22 to Government in Finance(L&E/B.G-1) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

11. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 8 above to the 12,525 Village Panchayats and 388 Panchayat Unions and 36 District Panchayats. The utilisation of the above Grant should be made as per the guidelines issued by Government of India and subsequently in the Guidelines issued vide G.O (Ms) No.18, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (PR-1) Department, dated 03.02.2021.
