ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, orders have been issued towards the Installation of Solar Power Plants without battery in the premises of Directorate, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme at the cost of ₹15.00 lakh for the purpose of conserving energy under Part II Schemes for the year 2014-2015.

2. In the letters 2nd read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that Job Training and Refresher Training Programmes are being conducted for Child Development Project Officers/Supervisors to implement Integrated Child Development Services Scheme effectively. These training programmes are conducted residentially in the premises of Directorate of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the employees from all the Districts. Due to the incidences of power cut on an average of 2 hours during the summer season, the conduction of training programme and furnishing immediate reports to Government in time are interrupted. Hence, Generator with 63 kw power and 75 Power System energy is being used during the time of power cuts with 5 connections. It consumes 16 litres Diesel per hour during summer and 14 litres per hour during the seasons of low temperature.

3. The solar power plant without battery with 17KW power (10KWP + 7KWP) which can be connected with main electricity have been installed and functioning from 06.02.2015. As there is no provision to connect battery in this structure, it is

connected and used along with EB connection No.300-56-70. Since solar electric power and generator are used simultaneously the consumption of fuel has been reduced considerably (ie) 16 litres Diesel/hour has been reduced to 10 litres /hour. There is no existing allocation of funds for fuel charges. The expenditure was met by using contingency funds allocated to this scheme till now.

4. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has requested the Government to sanction a sum of ₹27,360 towards fuel charges for the period from April 2015 to March 2016 (12 months i.e. 40 litres /month @ ₹57 per litre) for the generator being used in the Directorate of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme and issue necessary orders.

5. After careful examination, Government accept to fix 40 liters of fuel/diesel per month to provide uninterrupted power supply through Generator installed in the Directorate of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme and accord sanction for a sum of ₹ 27,360 (Rupees twenty seven thousand three hundred and sixty only) towards the fuel/diesel charges during 2015-2016.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited under the following Head of Account:

"2236-Nutrition-02-Distribution of nutritious food and beverages-101-Special Nutrition Programmes – Schemes in the Twelfth five year plan – III Centrally sponsored SF-Integrated Child Development Services Scheme - Phase - III- 45 – Petroleum, Oil and Lubricant. (D.P.C.2236-02-101-SF-4504).

7. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to include the above expenditure in the Budget Estimate in future.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.66100/Fin(SW)/2015, Dated 29.12.2015.
