Sub: Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department – Integrated Child Development Services Scheme – Provision of Mosquito Nets to all Anganwadi Centres of 30 Districts except Salem and Namakkal utilising the unspent amount available under the component of Pre School Education Kits under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme – Permission Reg.

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In the Government Order 1st cited, Government have issued orders for carrying out ECCE activities and procurement of PSE Education kits to all Anganwadi Centres for the year 2015-2016 to the tune of ₹ 1559.05 lakh.

2. In the Government Order 2nd cited, Government have issued orders for carrying out ECCE activities and procurement of PSE kits to all Anganwadi Centres for the year 2016-2017 to the tune of ₹ 1559.06 lakh.

3. In the letter 3rd cited, Government have permitted the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to authorise the DPO/CDPOs of Salem and Namakkal Districts to procure and supply the mosquito nets to the Anganwadi Centres @ ₹ 300 per mosquito net at the total cost of ₹ 5.00 lakh for each district on priority basis approved by the District Collectors of Salem and Namakkal on pilot basis utilising the unspent balance available under the component of Pre School Education Kits and carryout the ECCE activities for the year 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 following the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules, 2000 with proposed specifications. The District Programme Officers of Salem and Namakkal Districts have sent the Utilization Certificate and the photos regarding the usage of Mosquito Nets in their Districts.

4. In the letter 4th cited, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has also sent proposal stating that various benefits are being provided by the Government to the Children who are attending the Pre-school. Considering the present environmental factors and to prevent Mosquito bites to the Anganwadi children attending the Anganwadi Centre, it is proposed to provide mosquito nets to all Anganwadi Centres in 30 Districts except the Districts of Salem and Namakkal where the Mosquito Nets have already been provided to the Anganwadi Centres. The usage of Mosquito Nets in Anganwadi centres is highly welcomed by the parents of children and also found that the children are having undisturbed comfortable nap in Salem and Namakkal Districts.

5. In this context, a sum of ₹ 395.67 lakh and ₹ 626.91 lakh is still available pertaining to the year 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 under the component of Pre School Education Kits and carryout the ECCE activities. Therefore, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has proposed to extend the provision of Mosquito Nets to the remaining 50,144 Anganwadi Centres in the 30 Districts except Salem and Namakkal with specification of 10 x 6 x 6 feet (length x breath x height) per Anganwadi Centre at the rate of not exceeding ₹ 300 per mosquito net inclusive of all taxes and Transportation cost at a total cost of ₹ 1,50,43,200 (₹ 300 x 50,144 = ₹ 1,50,43,200). The total requirement for the provision of Mosquito Nets and specifications are furnished in Annexure. Hence, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the above proposal.

6. In the stated circumstances, Government permit the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to authorise the DPOS/CDPOs concerned to procure and supply the mosquito nets to all Anganwadi Centres in 30 Districts except Salem and Namakkal at the total cost of ₹ 1,50,43,200 @ ₹ 300 per Mosquito Net under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, utilising the unspent balance available under the component of Pre-School Education Kit and carryout the Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Council activities for the year 2015-2016 and 2016-2017 following the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules, 2000 as per the Annexure. Further, Government permit the Director, Integrated Child Development

Services Scheme to make inter-district/project transfer of funds based on the actual need/requirement within the overall Budget allocation.
