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ORDER:

In the letter 1st read above, Government of India, Ministry of Women and Child Development, among other things have approved the proposal for provision of uniform sarees (2 sarees @ ₹200 per saree, per annum and a Name tag (Badge @ ₹25 per badge / annum) to Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers and Mini Anganwadi Workers, every year under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, with sharing pattern of 90:10 between Government of India and State Government.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, Government of India, among other things, have enhanced the rate of uniform sarees as ₹300 per saree per annum and revised the sharing pattern from 90:10 to 75:25. The cost of Name Badges remaining the same.

3. In Government Order 3rd read above, sanction was accorded for a sum of ₹523.836 lakh towards the supply of 1,74,612 Uniform Sarees (two sarees per worker) at the rate of ₹300 each to Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers in the sharing pattern of 75:25 between Government of India and State Government. Accordingly the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent necessary Utilization Certificate for the above sanctioned amount.

4. In the letter 4th read above, Government of India have conveyed the Administrative approval for ₹760.08 crore inclusive of ₹487.21 lakh towards its 75% share for the supply of Uniform and badges to Anganwadi Employees for the year 2014-2015.

5. In the letter 5th read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹494.41 crore as Grants-in-aid towards implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2014-2015.

6. In the letter 6th read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal for the procurement and supply of Uniform sarees and Badges to the Anganwadi Workers for the year 2014-2015 stating that though Government of India have approved for provision of Name Badges to all Anganwadi Workers, Mini Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers @ ₹25 per Badge every year, it was not proposed to provide the Badges for the year 2013-2014 since the Name Badges were provided during the year 2013-2014 with the validity upto March 2014. Hence the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has proposed to provide the Name Badges to All Anganwadi Employees @ ₹25 per badge per employee at the total cost of ₹21.69 lakh for the year 2014-2015.

7. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has therefore requested the Government to permit him to procure 1,73,496 sarees from Co-optex, Chennai / Tamilnadu Textile Corporation, Coimbatore @ ₹300 per saree for ₹520.49 lakh in the sharing pattern of 75:25 and distribute the same through District Programme Officers to all Anganwadi Employees.

8. The expenditure towards the procurement and supply of Uniform sarees and Badges to Anganwadi Employees is as detailed below:-

9. After careful examination, in accordance with quotation prescribed by the Co-optex and as per the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998, Rules 2000 Government exemption is available for co-optex as clothing by the Government Department or the State Public Sector undertakings from Tamilnadu Handloom Weavers Co-operative Society (Co-optex), Government issues the following orders:-

- i. accord sanction for a sum of ₹4,72,78,000 (Rupees Four crore seventy two lakh and seventy eight thousand only) towards the procurement and supply of 1,73,496 uniform sarees at the rate of ₹260 per saree from Co-optex and Badges at the rate of ₹25 per Badge to 86,748 Anganwadi Employees for the year 2014-2015.
- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to procure and supply 1,73,496 Uniform Sarees (2 saree per worker) at the rate of ₹260 per saree from Co-optex and Badges at the rate of ₹25 per badge to 86,748 from the local markets following the procedures for procurement as laid down in Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules, 2000 for the year 2014-2015.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorised to draw and incur the amount sanctioned in para 9(i) above.
- iv. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to supply the Uniform Sarees and Badges through District Programme Officers to all Anganwadi Employees.
- v. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to submit the Utilization Certificate in time.

10. The amount sanctioned in para 9(i) above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"2236-Nutrition - 02 Distribution of nutritious food and beverages - 101 - Special Nutrition Programmes –Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored –SF-Integrated Child Development Services Scheme – Phase III 46 Clothing, Tentage and Stores (D.P.C.:2236-02-101-SF-4602).

11. Necessary additional funds of ₹50.44 lakh over and above budget provisions 2014-2015 will be provided in FMA 2014-2015. Pending provision of such funds in FMA 2014-2015, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned on paragraph 9(i) above. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme should include this additional expenditure while sending the proposal to the Government in Finance (SW) Department for inclusion in FMA 2014-2015 without fail. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is also requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes to Government in Finance (SW/BG-I) Department for inclusion of the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015.
