



## ABSTRACT

Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department- Integrated Child Development Services Scheme –Procurement and Supply of Pre-School Education Kits (Kit-B) for the year 2012-2013 – Sanction of expenditure of Rs.5,07,34,000/- – Orders – Issued.

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### ORDER:

The Government of India have instructed in their letter first read above to provide Pre-School Education Kit to the Child Centres (Anganwadi Centre) under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme namely Kit-A for the children in the age group of 0-3 years and Kit-B for the children in the age group of 3-6 years and each Child Centre could be provided one or the other kit in alternate years (Kit 'A' in one year and Kit 'B' in another year). There is no standard specification of items to procure, but the items in the kits should be multiple in terms of possible play activities and concepts, durable, safe for children (non- toxic and without sharp edges), manipulative, culturally and environmentally relevant, possessing fund value, cost-effective, easy to maintain and store and conducive to creativity and problem solving.

2. In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government of India have revised the amount for procurement of pre-school kits from Rs.500/- to Rs.1000/- per Centre per

annum in the case of Main Anganwadi Centre and for Mini Anganwadi Centre, the amount remains as Rs.250/- per Centre per annum.

3. In their letter No.4-3/2008-CD-1, Dated 11.11.2008, the Government of India have also revised the sharing pattern between Central and State Government under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme as 90:10 ratio from the year 2009-2010 except for Supplementary Nutrition Programme which remains at 50:50 sharing pattern.

4. In the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above orders were issued to provide Pre-School Kit (Kit-B) materials to 49,499 child centres and 4,940 Child Mini Centres in 2010-2011.

5. In the Government order 4<sup>th</sup> read above, Government have accorded sanction of Rs.5,07,34,000/- for procurement and supply of Pre-school Education Kit (A) for 49,499 Main Anganwadi Centres and 4,940 Mini Anganwadi Centres for the year 2011-12.

6. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, ICDS has now proposed to procure Pre-School Kit materials (Kit B) for each Anganwadi Centres containing the following items

- 1 Picture Story Book (Laminated version) containing pictures : 4 Nos.  
of vegetables, fruits, flowers, animal etc.
  - 2 Jigsaw Puzzles (minimum of 3 assembling pieces for one : 5 Nos.  
picture)
  - 3 Note Book for practicing stroke and curves/Circles/lines etc. : 20 Nos.  
(20 pages printed for practicing strokes to write A to Z) with  
colour crayons.
- for 49,499 Main Anganwadi Centres and each of the Mini Anganwadi Centres containing the following items
- 1 Picture Story Book (Laminated version) containing : 1 No.  
pictures of vegetables, fruits, flowers, animal etc.
  - 2 Note Book for practicing stroke and curves : 7 Nos.  
(20 pages printed for practicing strokes to write A  
to Z) with colour crayons.
  - 3 Soft Ball : 3 Nos.

to 4,940 Mini Anganwadi Centres functioning in all the Districts and requested to accord sanction for a sum of Rs.4,94,99,000/- (Rupees Four Crore ninety four lakh ninety nine thousand only) at the rate of Rs.1000/- per centre for 49,499 Main Anganwadi Centres and Rs.12,35,000/- (Rupees Twelve lakh thirty five thousand only) at the rate of Rs.250/- per centre for 4940 Mini Anganwadi Centres totalling Rs.5,07,34,000/- (Rupees Five crore Seven lakh thirty four thousand only) as per revised cost sharing pattern of 90:10 ratio between the centre and State Government.

7. The Government carefully examined the proposal of Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, ICDS and decided to accept it and accord sanction a sum of Rs.4,94,99,000/- (Rupees Four Crore ninety four lakh ninety nine thousand only) at the rate of Rs.1,000/- per kit per centre for 49,499 Child Centres (Anganwadi centres) and a sum of Rs.12,35,000/- (Rupees Twelve lakh thirty five thousand only) at the rate of Rs.250/- per kit per Mini centre for 4,940 Mini centres towards the procurement and Supply of Pre-School Education Kits (Kit B) as detailed in the annexure to this order. As per 90:10 sharing pattern the share of Government of India and State Government is as follows:

Government of India Share	90%	= Rs.4,56,60,600/-
State Government Share	10%	= Rs. 50,73,400/-
Total		= Rs.5,07,34,000/-

8. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services is authorised to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above and it shall be debited under the following head of account :-

"2236-Nutrition-02-Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages – 101 - Special Nutrition Programmes - Schemes in the Twelfth Five year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored - SF- Integrated Child Development Services Scheme-Phase III-24 Materials and Supplies " (DPC. 2236-02-101-SF-2408)

9. Further issues like non-toxicity of materials culturally and environmentally relevant aspects etc. for kits could not be ensured at the Child Development Project Officer level. These aspects on quality would effectively ensured only at the Commissioner level. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, ICDS may therefore take up centralised procurement following due Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tender's Act 1998 & Rules 2000.
