ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has announced on the floor of Assembly on 12.9.2011 under Rule 110 of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules, among other things, that effective steps have been taken by the Government, to ensure that children go to the Anganwadi Centres with great interest and to impart Pre-school Education to the children in the Anganwadi Centres through non-formal and play way method. To protect the children from extensive heat during the summer season and to ensure that the child centres are provided proper lighting facilities during the rainy and winter season, electrification of 45,345 Anganwadi Centres each with one fan and tube light along with internal wiring will be provided at a cost of Rs.27.21 crore.

2. Based on the above announcement, the Government in G.O.Ms.No.107, Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department, dated 1.12.2011, "in principle" orders among other things sanction was accorded for provision of electricity facility to 45,345 Anganwadi Centres including provision of one ceiling fan and one light at a cost of Rs.27.21 crore

- 3. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services in the letters second read above has stated that Integrated Child Development Services aims at providing and ensuring a natural, joyful, and stimulating environment for 3-6 years old children with emphasis on necessary inputs for optimal growth and development, infrastructure facilities of the Anganwadi Centre need to be best of its kind. Pre-school is one of the main component which is considered to be the backbone of the Integrated Child Development Services programme, and it provides a sound foundation for cumulative lifelong learning and development. To ensure effective learning ambience one of the initiative is to provide electricity facility to all the Anganwadi Centres functioning in Tamil Nadu.
- 4. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has also stated that the detailed estimates has been received from the District Collectors to carry out the electrification work by the Rural Development Department/Municipal Administration Department in a phased manner. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has also stated that in order to standardize the cost for providing electricity facility to the Anganwadi Centres, a sum of Rs.11,000/- per Anganwadi Centre may be fixed towards provision of one ceiling fan, tube light in class room, kitchen, store room, toilet and in the front yard of the Anganwadi Centre and towards Electricity Board connection and Labour charges and hence the total expenditure for providing electricity facility to 26,396 Anganwadi Centres @ Rs.11,000/- will be Rs.2903.56 lakhs or Rs.29.04 crore.
- 5. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has also suggested that a committee may be constituted to monitor the progress of the work of electricity facility to the Anganwadi Centres in a phased manner as detailed below:-

- 6. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has also stated that a sum of Rs.2000/- (to meet expenditure for documentation, stationery and refreshments charges) may be provided per monitoring meeting, per month and a sum of Rs.1,28,000/- would be required for conduct of the said monitoring meeting.
- 7. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has therefore requested the Government to standardise the cost for providing

electricity connection with fixtures to the Anganwadi Centre at Rs.11,000/- per Anganwadi Centre and also to take up the work in a phased manner and hence electrification facility may be provided to 12911 Anganwadi Centres at a cost of Rs.1420.21 lakh for the year 2011-12.

- 8. After detailed examination of the proposal of Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services, Government have decided to issue orders on the following:
 - i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.12,33,48,000/- (Rupees twelve crores thirty three lakh and forty eight thousand only) towards providing Electrification facility to 20,558 Anganwadi centres at a cost of Rs.6000/- per centre as detailed at Annexure to this order.
 - ii. The expenditures towards electrification of each Anganwadi centre and as detailed below:-

- iii. Out of the total cost, a sum of Rs.10,68,78,000/- is sanctioned to Rural Development Department towards electrification of 17,813 Anganwadi Centres by Rural Development Department and out of the total cost, a sum of Rs.1,64,70,000/- is sanctioned to Municipal Administration Department towards electrification of 2,745 Anganwadi Centres by Municipal Administration Department.
- iv. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services is requested to take follow up action for ensuring electrification of Anganwadi Centres functioning in Private building by taking up with owners.
- v. The recurring electricity charges shall be met out by the concerned local bodies.

9. The expenditure sanctioned at para 8 above shall be debited under the following heads of account:

- 10. The Government also accord sanction to constitute the Monitoring Committee as detailed in para 5 above to monitor the work of providing electricity facility and to ensure that they are carried out expeditiously. The District Collector shall be empowered to make internal arrangements to re-allocate the saving amount available in one centre to the other needy centre within the total provision.
- 11. The Expenditure sanctioned in para 8 above constitute an item of New Service. The approval of the Legislative will be obtained in due course pending approval of the Legislature the expenditure will initially be met from an advance drawn from the contingency fund, orders regarding which will be issued separately in Finance (BG-I) Department. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration / Commissioner of Rural Development is directed to apply for sanctioning contingency find in the Prescribed format along with the copy of this order to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration/ Commissioner of Rural Development is also directed to send necessary notes to Government in Finance Department for inclusion of the Expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates to obtain the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate time.
- 12. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration/Commissioner, Rural Development, is the Estimating, Reconciling and controlling authority of the above new head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officer/Treasure Officer concerned are directed to open the above new head of account in their accounts. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration/ Commissioner of Rural Development is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 9 above.

- 13. Electrical works in the Pudukottai Assembly constituency Anganwadi should be taken up only after the by election process is over.
- 14. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (RD)/ (MAWS)/(SW) Department vide its U.O.No.164/DS(VS)/2012, dated 03.5.2012 with Additional Sanction Ledger No.184 (One hundred and eighty four).
