ORDER:

Training is one of the most crucial component in the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for improving and maintaining the quality of performance of the project personnel at all levels and has been geared up towards improving Knowledge, Skills and Capabilities of all functionaries especially frontline workers so that they are not only better service providers but also mobilizers of community towards desirable behavioural change. The aim of the training is to develop

all the functionaries of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme into Agents of Social Change instead of simply reacting to the situation and to bring about behavioural change in the community.

- 2. In the letter 1st read above, Government of India have introduced and approved towards imparting Job & Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers, Job /Orientation Training and Refresher Training to Anganwadi Helpers under Regular Training programmes of State Training Action Plan (STRAP).
- 3. In the letter 2nd read above, Government of India have approved the revised cost norms, budgets for various types of regular training Programmes (induction/job/refresher) under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme functionaries.
- 4. In the Government Order 3rd read above, Government have sanctioned for a sum of ₹3,02,81,250 towards imparting Job & Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers and Job/Orientation and Refresher Training to Anganwadi Helpers for the year 2013-2014. Accordingly, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent Utilization Certificate for the above sanctioned amount.
- 5. In the letter 4th read above, Government of India have conveyed the administrative approval for ₹760.09 crore inclusive of ₹2168.76 lakh as 90% of Government of India share towards imparting regular training during the year 2014-2015.
- 6. In the letter 5th read above, Government of India have conveyed approval for STRAP to a tune of ₹ 1021.15 lakh under "Regular Training" and "Other Training" Programmes under STRAP for the year 2014-2015.
- 7. In the letter 6th and 7th read above, Government of India have released exclusively a sum of ₹ 562.81 lakh as 1st and 2nd instalments for imparting Regular Training Programme for the year 2014-2015.
- 8. Government of India have approved to impart the following under STRAP for the year 2014-2015.

Regular Training Programmes

- (i) Refresher Training to 21,920 Anganwadi Workers in 548 batches at the rate of ₹68,000 per batch with a total cost of ₹3,72,64,000 (Rupees three crore seventy two lakh and sixty four thousand only).
- (ii) Refresher Training to 24,250 Anganwadi Helpers in 485 Batches at the rate of ₹66,500 per batch with a total cost of ₹3,22,53,000 (Rupees three crore twenty two lakh and fifty three thousand only).
- (iii) To establish essential infrastructure for the newly identified 5 District Offices as Regional Training Centres at the rate of ₹2.50 lakh per district with a total cost of ₹12.50 lakh.

9. In the letter 8th read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal to Government for imparting Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers & Anganwadi Helpers and to establish newly identified 5 District Offices as Regional Training Centres under regular Training Programme and Induction Training to Link Volunteers in 18 Districts (in Tribal areas), Training to Anganwadi-cum-Creche Workers and Helpers and strengthening of State Training Institute under Other Training Programmes under State Training Action Plan (STRAP) for the year 2014-2015 as detailed below:-

Regular Training:-

- Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers:-
- The Refresher Training is a regular and routine in the pattern of Training strategy. It would be need based and focused to update their existing knowledge, skill and attitude and shall be necessary for bringing an attitudinal change and behavioural changes among themselves and in the community thus proving themselves as good social change agent. The Refresher Training would be given to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers who have completed two years after the Job Training periodically.
- The Refresher Training programme to the Anganwadi Workers and Helpers will be organized at the project level by the Grade-I Supervisor simultaneously in all the Projects as Tamil Nadu have a decentralized pattern of Training and also this is a Non residential programme.

Newly Identified 5 District Offices as Regional Training Centres:-

In Tamilnadu, Anganwadi Training Centres does not exist in operation. At district level, District training team consists of 4 members who act as a good support and facilitate to the Block/ Project Trainers. These teams supervise the training at the project level and guide the trainers and they also go to the field and do the follow up visit to Anganwadi Centre.

Mobile Training Team:-

There are 2 Mobile Training Teams available in Tamilnadu viz., in Chennai and Kancheepuram Districts. Each Mobile Training Team has 3 Instructors to carry out the work of the Block/Project trainers wherever no Block/Project level trainers are available.

Block / Project Level:-

Every Block/ Project has a trainer. Most of the trainers have been working since Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project –I and were recruited exclusively for the project. They have rich experience in the field of Nutrition, Health, Child Development etc. The unique feature is that these trainers conduct all the field training, visit centre, provide guidance on the spot to the workers and helpers.

As there is no Anganwadi Training Centres in Tamilnadu, the Job and Refresher Training to grass root level functionaries are being under taken by the Project Level Trainers in order to create a conducive atmosphere for learning, Creation of Regional Level Training Centre is essential. In this regard, in Tamil Nadu, five District Programme Offices have been identified as Regional Training Centres viz. Chennai, Coimbatore, Madurai, Trichirapalli and Tirunelveli. To establish essential infrastructure like, furniture, furnishing class rooms and audio visual aids like Projector, Laptop, Flannel Board, White Board etc., an amount of ₹12.50 lakh to be provided for the newly identified Regional Level Training Centres @ ₹2.50 lakh per district.

10. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has restricted the proposal to the actual working days and not for the duration so as to avoid surrender of funds because of decentralized pattern of training which do not require too much funds for TA/DA to the trainees and the total amount worked out as ₹3,31,01,000 towards imparting Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers under Regular Training programmes and other training programmes of State Training Action Plan (STRAP). The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of ₹3,31,01,000 for imparting above Training Programme under State Training Action Plan (STRAP) for the year 2014-2015.

- 12. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-
- i. Government accord sanction for a sum of ₹3,31,01,000 (Rupees Three crore thirty one lakh and one thousand only) for imparting Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers & Anganwadi Helpers and to establish newly identified 5 District Offices as Regional Training Centres under regular Training Programme and Induction Training to Link Volunteers in 18 Districts (in Tribal areas), Training to Anganwadi-cum-Creche Workers and Helpers and strengthening of State Training Institute under Other Training Programmes under STRAP for the year 2014-2015 as per Annexure I & VI to this order in the sharing pattern of 90:10 (GOI share ₹2,97,90,900, State share ₹33,10,100).
- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to circulate the curriculum duly incorporating the State specific issues and need based on the guidelines prescribed by the Government of India to the District Programme Officers for imparting Refresher Training to Anganwadi Workers and Anganwadi Helpers.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw the amount in advance and incur the expenditure as indicated in the Annexure- V-II(A) and Annexure-VI under Article-99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume-I.
- iv. The concerned District Programme Officers are authorized to draw the amount in advance and incur the expenditure as indicated in the Annexure I-IV and V-(I), (II) (B&C) under Article 99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume I subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The District Programme Officers are directed to render relevant statement of accounts and report to the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme as soon as the training programmes are completed so as to enable the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to report the same to the Government of India/State Government
 - b. The District Programme Officers are directed to adjust the advance drawn under Article 99 Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume I at the Treasury/Pay and Accounts Office concerned soon after the Training Programmes are completed.
 - c. The Pay and Accounts Officer/Treasury Officers concerned are advised to honour the bill as and when presented by the District Programme Officers concerned.
 - d. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to submit necessary Utilization Certificate to Government within the time.

- 13. The expenditure sanctioned in para 12 (i) above shall be debited in the following Head of Account:
