ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have stated that the training on Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) is to be conducted in a cascade model at three levels, first by experts (National Institute of Public Cooperation and Child Development); Second by State Level Master Trainers (SLMTs) and at the third level by District Level Master Trainers (DLMTs). It is further stated that the detailed training proposals, in respect of District Level Master Trainers (DLMTs) and Anganwadi Workers of the State, for training on Early Childhood Care and Education may be finalized based on the prescribed financial norms and submitted to the Government of India for approval as part of the State Annual Programme Implementation Plan. The brief modalities of the training are as follows:-

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, orders have issued, among other things, sanctioning a sum of ₹9,25,48,000 with the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Central Government and State Government towards conducting 695 batches of Phase-I (6 days) and 1,332 batches Phase-II (3 days) training on Early Childhood Care and Education to Anganwadi Worker for the year 2018-2019.
- 3. In the letter third read above, the Government of India have given approval for a sum of ₹2721.95 lakh with the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Central Government and State Government at the rate of ₹5,000 per Anganwadi Centre per Annum towards procurement of Pre-School Education Kits, Printing of Early Childhood Care Education materials viz., Activity Books, Assessment Cards etc. inclusive of Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) Training to Anganwadi Workers for the year 2019-2020.
- 4. In the letter fourth read above, the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services has stated that in Tamil Nadu, 54,439 Anganwadi Centres are functioning and it is therefore necessary to conduct 1,361 batches (Batch size 40) of Training to Anganwadi Workers on Early Childhood Care and Education for all three Phases and 1,361 batches of Phase–I and 1,332 batches of Phase-II training on Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) to Anganwadi Workers have been conducted during the year 2018-2019 and training on Early Childhood Care and Education to Anganwadi Workers for 29 batches of Phase-II and 1,361 batches of Phase-III training has to be conducted during the year 2019-2020.
- 5. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services has requested to sanction a sum of ₹9,86,000 towards conducting 29 batches of Phase–II, (3 days) (remaining batches) and a sum of ₹4,62,74,000 towards conducting 1,361 batches, Phase-II (3 days) training on Early Childhood Care and Education to Anganwadi Workers at sector level with the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Central Government and State Government during the year 2019-2020. The details of items of expenditure and requirement of expenditure for the above training are as follows:-

- 6. After careful examination of the proposal of the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services, the Government issue the following order:
 - i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of ₹9,86,000 (Rupees nine lakh and eighty six thousand only) with the sharing pattern 60:40 between Central Government and State Government (60% of Central Government share being ₹5,91,600 and 40% of State share being ₹3,94,400) towards conducting 29 batches of phase-II training (remaining batches) (3 days) on Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) to Anganwadi Worker as indicated in para-5 above at sector level during the year 2019-2020 subject to conditions that the Government of India's guidelines and schematic norms should be followed scrupulously.
 - ii. Sanction is accorded for a sum of ₹4,62,74,000 (Rupees four crore sixty two lakh and seventy four thousand only) with the sharing pattern 60:40 between Central Government and State Government (60% of Central Government share being ₹2,77,64,400 and 40% of State Government share being ₹1,85,09,600) towards conducting 1,361 batches of

phase-III training on Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) to Anganwadi Workers as indicated in para-5 above at sector level during the year 2019-2020 subject to the condition that the Government of India's guidelines and schematic norms should be followed scrupulously.

- The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services is authorized to circulate the Training schedule shared by Government of India duly incorporating the State specific issues and need based on the guidelines prescribed by the Government of India to the District Project Officers for conducting the Level-1 Training to Anganwadi Workers for Early Childhood Care and Education for Phase-II & III Training.
- iv. The District Project Officers concerned are authorized to draw the expenditure sanctioned in para-6(i) and (ii) as advance under Article-99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume-I subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The District Project Officers concerned are directed to render relevant statement of accounts and reports to the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services as soon as the training programmes are over, so as to enable the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services to report to both Central / State Governments.
 - b. The District Project Officers concerned are directed to adjust the advance drawn under Article-99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume-I at the Treasury / Pay and Accounts Office concerned soon after the Training Programmes are completed.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"2236. Nutrition-02-Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages- 101-Special Nutrition Programmes – Central Sector Schemes – SC - Integrated Child Development Services Scheme- 372-Training-01-Training" (D.P. Code 2236-02-101-SC-37201).
