Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department – Integrated Child Development Services Scheme - Procurement and supply of Utensils like Plates and Tumblers, Storage Bins, Kadai and Karandi to all Anganwadi Centres at the cost of ₹9,27,98,250 for the year 2014-2015 – Sanction – Orders – Issued.

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ORDER:

In the letter 1st read above, Government of India have evolved a broad framework for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. Further, Government of India have also revised the existing norms/unit cost/sharing pattern of certain schemes under restructured pattern of the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in MISSION MODE. The details of the revised cost of Equipment / Furniture is detailed below:-

2. In the Government Order 2nd read above, Government have sanctioned a sum of ₹22,23,243 towards the procurement and supply of Kadai and Karandi to 3,963 Anganwadi Centres for implementing the New Variety Menu under Puratchi Thalaivar MGR Nutritious Meal Programme for the year 2013-2014 and the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has furnished necessary Utilization Certificate for the above sanctioned expenditure.

3. In the letter 3rd read above, Government of India have conveyed the administrative approval for ₹760.09 crore inclusive of ₹835.18 lakh as 90% of Government of India share towards the purchase of vessels like Plates and Tumblers, Storage Bins, Kadai and Karandi as per the requirement to the 49,499 Main and 4,940 Mini Anganwadi centres under the component of Equipment /Furniture during 2014-2015.

4. In the letters 4th read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹494.41 crore under General Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2014-2015.

5. In the letter 5th read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that the children are provided with Plates and Tumblers to consume their Nutritious Meal every day. Most of the plates and tumblers now available with the Anganwadi Centres are in damaged condition which have to be replaced. As of now, 8,19,599 Nos. of new plates and 8,19,599 Nos. of new tumblers are required. In order to provide hot cooked meal to the Anganwadi children in a hygienic way, it is necessary to provide plates and tumblers to the children. Further, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has also stated that the Storage Bins are also required for Anganwadi Centres to preserve food commodities like Rice, Weaning Food, Grams and other Masala items used every day for cooking hot nutritious meal. Since the Storage Bins have already been provided only to 38,506 Centres, balance 15,933 Anganwadi Centres need to be provided with the same for the safe storage of food items.

6. Provision of other kitchen vessels such as kadai and karandi are also necessary for the effective implementation of newly introduced variety meal scheme under PT MGR Nutritious Meal Programme in Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. 3,963 Anganwadi centres of pilot blocks have already been provided with Kadai and Karandi in which Variety Rice Scheme is implemented. The

balance 50,476 Anganwadi centres need to be provided with Kadai and Karandi. Hence, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

7. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-

- i. Accord sanction for a sum of ₹9,27,98,250 (Rupees Nine crore twenty seven lakh ninety eight thousand two hundred and fifty only) towards the procurement and supply of vessels like Plates and Tumblers, Storage Bins, Kadai and Karandi as per the requirement to the 49,499 Main & 4,940 Mini Anganwadi Centres under the component of Equipment /Furniture in the sharing pattern of 90:10 for the year 2014-2015.
- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to procure and supply the Vessels as per the specifications furnished in Annexure-II, based on the requirement of Districts furnished in Annexure-I to 49,499 Main Anganwadi Centres not exceeding, ₹1,750 Per centre and 4,940 Mini Anganwadi Centres not exceeding, ₹1,250 per centre by following centralized tender procedure of Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules 2000.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to draw and incur the amount sanctioned in para 7 (i) above.
- iv. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to submit the Utilization Certificate in time.

8. The amount sanctioned in para 7(i) above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

2236-Nutrition – 02 – Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages – 101
 – Special Nutrition Programmes – UE – Strengthening and Restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme – 24 Materials & Supplies”. (D.P.C: 2236-02-101-UE-2408)

9. Necessary additional funds will be provided in FMA 2014-2015. Pending provision of such funds in FMA 2014-2015, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned on paragraph 7(i) above. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme should include this additional expenditure while sending the proposal to the Government in Finance (SW) Department for inclusion in FMA 2014-2015 without fail. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is also requested to send

necessary draft explanatory notes to Government in Finance (SW/BG-1) Department for inclusion of the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O. No.3357/Fin(SW)/2015, Dated 05.02.2015 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 2419 (Two thousand four hundred and nineteen).
