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### ORDER:-

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Government of India have evolved a broad framework for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of ICDS. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a "Vibrant ECD centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care. Under the State ICDS Mission, Government of India have approved the organisational setup with various human resources inclusive of Contractual Staff.

2. In the letters 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government of India have approved and conveyed the staffing structure for Consultants/outsourced personnel at various levels under the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme Mission for Tamilnadu as detailed below: -

3. Government of India have also approved and conveyed the terms of Reference for consultants/outsourced personnel under the ICDS Mission.

4. In the letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Government have approved to appoint only one Consultant for Monitoring and Evaluation. Accordingly, in the Government order 4<sup>th</sup> read above, orders have been issued towards the appointment of Consultant on contractual basis by fixing a pay of ₹ 50,000 per month under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme at the cost of ₹ 6.00 lakh per annum.

5. In the letters 5<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹ 358.19 crore towards the effective implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2015-2016 and requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

6. In the letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that as per orders issued by Government, one consultant was appointed on contractual basis following due procedures by fixing a pay of ₹ 50,000 per month for a period of one year since October 2014 and will end by 30.09.2015 afternoon. The engagement of Consultant on contractual basis has been highly effective for the day to day work flow of the Monitoring component and the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has recommended to utilize the services of the Consultant for one more year for the period from 01.10.2015 to 30.09.2016 and requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

7. In the letter 7<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have modified the existing sharing ratio for all components of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, except Supplementary Nutrition (SNP), as 60:40 between Centre and States, cost sharing ratio for Supplementary Nutrition Programme will remain unchanged/same at 50:50. Accordingly, vide letter 8<sup>th</sup> read above, the revised APIP of 2015-2016 approved by the Chairperson/Chief Secretary of State Empowered Programme Committee has also been sent to Government of India inclusive of the component of salary to contractual post under Restructuring of ICDS.

8. The annual expenditure towards engaging the Consultant for 12 more months will be ₹ 6,00,000 which will be shared by the Government of India and State Government on 60:40 sharing basis as detailed below:

9. After careful examination, Government have permitted the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to continue the post of Consultant on contractual basis for a period of one year i.e. 2015-2016 under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for Monitoring as per the guidelines of Government of India regarding the qualification, age, experience etc.

10. Accordingly, Government accord sanction for a sum of ₹6,00,000 (Rupees six lakh only) towards the recurring expenditure on the continuance of the Consultant post @ ₹50,000 per month in the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Government of India and Government of Tamilnadu. (Government of India share ₹3,60,000, State Share ₹2,40,000).

11. The expenditure sanctioned in para 10 above shall be debited under the following Head of account:

2236 – Nutrition- 02 – Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages - 101 – Special Nutrition programmes – schemes in the Twelfth Five year plan VI. schemes shared between State and Centre UE- Strengthening and Restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme 33- Payments for professional and Special services – 04 – contract payment.
