ORDER:-

In the Government Order 1st read above, Government have permitted the Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to form a Committee at the District Level with the following Members for identification of Lands to construct the Anganwadi Centres.

Further, Government have also issued Guidelines with the Technical specifications for the construction of New Anganwadi centre.

2. In the Letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government of India have evolved Broad Frame work for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a "Vibrant ECD centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic, physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care. Further Government of India have also launched new components under Restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme inclusive of the Construction of New Anganwadi Centre Building at Rs.4.50 lakh per Anganwadi Centres in the sharing pattern of 75:25 between Centre and State.

3. In the D.O. Letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above Government of India have approved the Construction of Anganwadi Centres for the first time under Restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme during 12<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan. Further, Government of India have also approved the Construction of Anganwadi Centres as an eligible and authorised activity under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 and issued Gazette Notification vide No 2,274 dated 22.11.2012 which enables to take up the Construction of Anganwadi Centres in all villages where the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme do not have pucca Anganwadi Centres or where the existing Anganwadi Centres are running on rent or in the open.

4. Government of India have also approved a cost norm of Rs.4.5 lakh per unit and Government of India have further stated that there is a need to take up labour intensive Construction of Anganwadi Centres to make maximum use of Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005. As Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 provides funds in the ratio of 60:40 for labour and material components, there may be a need to provide additional funds for material component to meet the total cost of Construction of the Anganwadi Centre. The plan of action for Construction of Anganwadi Centres should be able to throw up the demand of such additional funds and this requirement must also simultaneously be reflected in the Annual Programme Implementation Plans (AIP) of the State under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for different years. Ministry of Women and Child Development would meet this cost on the basis of 75:25 between the Centre and the States.

5. In the Letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above Government of India have approved 13 Districts in Tamilnadu where the restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme rolled out during 2013-2014 as detailed below:-

6. In the Letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have conveyed administrative approval of Annual Programme Implementation Plans (APIP) 2013 – 2014 in respect of Tamilnadu for Rs.760.14 crore towards the Government of India share inclusive of the Construction of New Anganwadi Centre Building at Rs.4.50 lakh per Anganwadi Centres to the tune of Rs.77.90 crore (75% of Government of India share) in the sharing pattern of 75:25.

7. In the Letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have released a sum of Rs.3,788.81 lakh (Government of India 75% share) as first instalment of Grant-in-aid towards the Construction of 1,731 New Anganwadi Centres at Rs.4.50 lakh per Anganwadi Centre in the sharing pattern of 75:25 and also sent the details of specifications towards the construction.

8. In the Letter 7<sup>th</sup> read above, the Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme was conceived in 1,975 with an integrated delivery package of early childhood services inclusive of Supplementary Nutrition, Pre School Education, Immunisation, Health Check-ups, Referral Services and Nutrition and Health Education through Anganwadi Centres. Hence, it is imperative to strengthen the infrastructure of the Anganwadi Centres for the safe and effective implementation of the scheme.

9. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner has also stated that 41,563 Anganwadi Centres (76%) out of 54,439 Anganwadi Centres are functioning in Government Buildings. Hence the balance 12,876 Anganwadi Centres to be constructed/accommodated in the new building in a phased manner. After construction of buildings under various schemes such as Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, Town Panchayat, Municipality, Corporation and Community Contribution, the number of Anganwadi Centres functioning in private buildings have come down to 12,876. After the identification of lands in Village Panchayat, Town Panchayat, Municipality, Corporation etc. the number of buildings to be constructed for the year 2013-2014 in Village Panchayat is 1,040, Town Panchayat is 432, Municipality is 173, and in Corporation is 86, as detailed in the Annexure to this Government Order. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has also furnished the District Wise details.

10. If the authorities have not given consent to donate the lands in case of Temple lands which are identified for the construction of New Anganwadi Centres, those lands could be taken on long lease. In regard to this, separate guidelines may



be issued by the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme.

11. Further, The Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has also stated that dovetailing funds from various schemes will be done only where the cost of construction of Anganwadi Centre exceeds Rs.4.50 lakh. The aforesaid Committee will be entrusted with the monitoring of the Construction of Anganwadi Centres with its quality and to furnish the Completion Certificate to the Principal Secretary/Commissioner/Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme which will be compiled for onward submission to Government. Hence, the Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has requested the Government to accord sanction a sum of Rs.7,789.50 lakh towards the construction of 1,731 New Anganwadi Centres at the rate of Rs.4.50 lakh per Anganwadi Centre and in case of any surrender, permission may be granted to the Mission Director and Principal Secretary/ Commissioner to utilize the funds through inter district and intra district diversions based on the actual need, if required. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme may also be allowed to do intra and inter district change in number of Anganwadi centres based on the actual need / public request / representations etc.

12. In the first meeting to review the progress of Infrastructure of Anganwadi Centres and further works to be carried out held on 07.02.2014 under the Chairpersonship of Principal Secretary, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, it was decided that the funds received from Government of India under MISSION MODE for the construction of 1,731 New Anganwadi Centres may be utilised for the construction of Anganwadi Centres in urban areas.

13. After careful examination, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.47,36,01,250/- (Rupees forty seven crore thirty six lakh one thousand two hundred and fifty only) as first instalment released by Government of India towards the construction of 1,731 new Anganwadi Centres as detailed in the Annexure at the rate of Rs.4.50 lakh per Anganwadi Centre in the sharing pattern of 75:25 (Government of India 75% release Rs.37,88,81,000/- + Rs.9,47,20,250/).

14. The expenditure sanctioned in para 13(i) shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under Demand No.45 Heads of Department-04:

4236 Capital Outlay On Nutrition – 80. General – 800. Other Expenditure –vi Schemes shared between state and centre UB Construction of Anganwadi Centres under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Service Scheme – 16 Major Works. (DPC: 4236 80 800 UB 16 01)

15. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Service Scheme is estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new head of account. The concerned Pay Accounts Officer/Treasury Officers are requested to open the above new head of account in their books of accounts.

16. The Expenditure sanctioned at para 13 shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course of time by directly included in the First Supplementary Estimates for the year 2014-2015. The



Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Service Scheme is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for including the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2014-2015 without fail.

- i. The District Collectors concerned are requested to identify the suitable lands/sites immediately for the construction of 1,731 New Anganwadi Centres under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme.
- ii. The Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to form the District Level Committee as per the orders issued in G.O.(Ms).No.40, Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme (SW-7(1) Department Dated 26.3.2012.
- iii. The District Collectors concerned are authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned above to the Project Director (DRDA) for the construction of Anganwadi Centres in the Village Panchayat, and Executive Officers of Town Panchayat for the construction of Anganwadi Centres in the Town Panchayat and Commissioners of Corporation and Municipalities for the construction of Anganwadi Centres in the Municipal Area.
- iv. The District Collectors concerned are requested to obtain Land alienation/No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the concerned authorities before commencing the construction of New Anganwadi Centres.
- v. The District Collectors concerned are requested to follow the conditions/guidelines stipulated in the G.O. (Ms). No.40, Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme (SW-7(1) Department, Dated 26.3.2012 in respect of the construction of new Anganwadi centres and ensuring that the children should not travel more than 1 k.m. from their residence.
- vi. The District Collectors concerned are requested to send necessary Utilisation Certificate after executing the construction to the Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for onward submission to Government of India.

17. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O.No23910/DS(V)/Fin(SW)/2014, Dated. 16.5.2014 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.291 (Two Hundred and Ninety one)
