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ORDER:

The Government of India, in their letter 1st read above have introduced a new Scheme called "Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowerment of Adolescent Girls" (RGSEAG – SABLA) on pilot basis initially in 200 districts in the country inclusive of 9 selected Districts in Tamil Nadu which are Salem, Thiruvannamalai, Cuddalore, Ramanathapuram, Madurai, Tiruchirappalli, Coimbatore, Chennai and Kanyakumari. The Government of India have stated that in the selected districts, SABLA Scheme would replace the existing Nutrition Programme for Adolescent Girls (NPAG) and Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme (KSY) and in the remaining districts, Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme where operational, would continue as before.

2. In the Government Order 2nd read above sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.162.25 lakh for conducting Vocational Training Programme for Adolescent Girls under Kishori Shakti Yojana in 22 districts at the level of first instalment of grants released by Government of India for implementing the Kishori Shakti Yojana for the year 2011-12.

3. In the reference 3rd read above Government of India has released a sum of Rs.264.97 lakh as first instalment of grants-in-aid during 2012-2013 for implementation of Kishori Shakti Yojana.

4. In the reference 4th read above the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has sent the proposal for the implementation of Kishori Shakti Yojana for the year 2012-13 in 295 projects at the rate of Rs.1.10 lakh per project as detailed in the Annexure I & II at a total cost of Rs.3,24,50,000/- as detailed below:-

5. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner has requested the Government to authorise her for imparting of Vocational Training through NGOs/Reputed Institutions etc. at State level by inviting Tenders as per Tamil Nadu Tender Transparency Act 1998, Rules 2000 and it will be implemented with co-ordination of District Programme Officers in districts depending on their requirements in the districts. Vocational Training will be district specific/area specific and to encourage Adolescent girls to get placements in the nearby places. She has also requested for providing Training kits/mela/IEC activities as per Government of India guidelines to the beneficiaries, if any balance is left, because of effective negotiations and also requested to permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner of Integrated Child Development Services to draw the amount @ Rs.1,10,000/- per Project for 295 Projects in 23 districts as advance under Article 99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume I for implementing Kishori Shakti Yojana programme as per Government of India guidelines. A sum of Rs.324.5 lakh is available in Budget for 2012-13 under the relevant Head of Account.

6. The Government examined the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme, and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.264.97 lakh (Rupees Two Crore sixty four lakh and ninety seven thousand only) for conducting Vocational Training and Orientation Training programme under Kishori Shakti Yojana in 23 districts for the year 2012-13 at the level of first instalment of grants in aid released by Government of India. As and when the further release is received from Government of India for the above scheme the additional sanction shall be made in future.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited under the following head of account:

8. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to draw the amount as advance under Article 99 of Tamil Nadu Finance code Volume I for conducting Vocational Training and Orientation camps and for providing Training Kit conducting camps / melas etc to the beneficiaries if any balance is left because of effective negotiation and adjust the same

after completion of the Programme with the Pay and Accounts Officer concerned and to send Utilisation Certificate to the Government.

9. The entire expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be met by Government of India 100% (Centrally sponsored Scheme).

10. The Government also grant permission to the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to disburse the amount to the District Programme Officers/Child Development Project Officers for imparting Vocational Training to the Adolescent Girls through Non-Governmental Organisations / Reputed Institutions, etc at State level by inviting tenders as per Tamil Nadu Tender Transparency Act, 1998, Rules 2000 and it will be implemented with Co-ordination of District Programme Officers in districts depending on their requirement in the district Vocational Training will be district specific area specific and to encourage adolescent girls to get placements in the nearby places.

11. The Pay and Account Officer is directed to admit the bills as and when presented by the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme if otherwise found in order.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O.No.55860/Fin(SW)/2012, dated.05.10.2012.
