



## ABSTRACT

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### ORDER:

In the letter first read above, Government of India have approved a sum of ₹ 12,000 per Anganwadi Centre for construction of toilets to the Anganwadi Centres functioning in Government owned buildings.

2. In the minutes second read above, National Empowered Programme Committee has approved to construct toilets to the Anganwadi Centres functioning in the Government buildings without having toilet facilities.

3. In the letters third read above, Government of India have sanctioned/released a sum of ₹ 360.89 crore under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme during 2017-2018.

4. In the letter fourth read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal to Government to accord sanction for a sum of ₹ 1,17,12,000 towards the construction of toilets to 976 Anganwadi Centres which do not have toilet facilities through Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department

as approved by Government of India for the year 2017-2018 in the sharing pattern of 60:40 between Government of India and State Government. The Director of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has also requested to permit him to draw the entire amount and credit the said amount to Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department's personal deposit account by Contra credit basis. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has furnished the district-wise details.

5. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:

- i. to accord sanction of ₹ 1,17,12,000 (Rupees One crore seventeen lakh and twelve thousand only) towards the construction of 976 toilets to the Anganwadi Centres functioning in the Government buildings without having toilet facilities for the year 2017-2018 as per annexure and Government of India norms in the sharing pattern of 60:40 (GOI share = ₹ 70,27,200 and State share = ₹ 46,84,800).
- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to monitor the progress of the construction and initiate speedy action towards the completion of the construction of toilets in the Anganwadi centres.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to furnish the utilisation certificate to Government within time.

6. The expenditure sanctioned above shall be debited under the following New Head of Account:-

"4236 – Capital Outlay on Nutrition – 80 – General – 800 – Other Expenditure – Schemes Shared between State and Centre – UC – Construction of Toilets to the Anganwadi Centres – 16 Major works. (DPC 4236 – 80 – 800 UC – 1609).

7. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority of the above new head of account.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may initially be met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Schemes is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. The orders for release of the amount from the Contingency Fund will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for

inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2018-2019 to Finance (BG-I/SW) at the appropriate time without fail.

9. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to draw the entire amount and credit the same to Department of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department personal deposit account by contra credit basis.

10. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department is requested to dovetail balance funds needed from the existing schemes implemented by the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department for the completion of the toilets to the Anganwadi Centres. He is also requested to ensure that the toilet constructed are child friendly and the type design is to be finalised accordingly.

11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O.No.22699/Fin(SW)/2018, Dated: 14.05.2018 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 262 (Two hundred and sixty two).
