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ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued for the implementation of Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme during 2009-2010 to undertake Vocational Training Programme for Adolescent Girls in all the 434 Projects in Tamil Nadu under Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme at the rate of Rs.1,10,000/- per Project per annum at a total cost of Rs.4,77,39,000/-.

2. The Government of India, in their letter second read above have introduced a "New Scheme" called "Rajiv Gandhi Scheme for Empowerment of Adolescent Girls" (RGSEAG – SABLA) on pilot basis initially in 200 districts in the country inclusive of Nine selected Districts in Tamil Nadu which are Salem, Thiruvannamalai, Cuddalore, Ramanathapuram, Madurai, Tiruchirappalli, Coimbatore, Chennai and Kanyakumari. The Government of India have stated that in the selected districts, SABLA Scheme

would replace the existing Nutrition Programme for Adolescent Girls (NPAG) and Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme (KSY) and in the remaining districts, Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme where operational, would continue as before.

3. In the Government Order third read above, sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.2,65,05,750/- to implement the Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme in 295 projects covering 22 Districts for imparting Vocational Training at the rate of Rs.89,850/- per project. In the letter fourth read above Government of India have released a sum of Rs.162.25 lakh as first Instalment for the implementation of Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme for the year 2011-12.

4. Accordingly, the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services, has sent proposal to the Government to accord sanction for implementation of Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme in the 295 Integrated Child Development Services Scheme Projects in the State, for conducting Vocational Training at the rate of Rs.1.10 lakh per project at a total cost of Rs.3,24,50,000/- as detailed below:

5. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services has requested the Government to permit her to draw the amount of Rs.3,24,50,000/- (Rupees Three Crore twenty four lakh fifty thousand only) at the rate of Rs.1,10,000/- per project for 295 projects in 22 districts (Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme districts) as advance under Article 99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume I for conducting Vocational Training and Orientation Programme as per Government of India guidelines and also to provide training kits, conducting camps/melas etc. to the beneficiaries, if any balance is left because of effective negotiations. She has further requested to authorize her to disburse the amount to Programme Officers/Child Development Project Officers for imparting Vocational Training and Orientation Programme and to conduct the Vocational Training through NGOs/Reputed Institutions/ITI/VTPs under NSDP/NGOS registered under Health Department/NRHM /MAHALIR THITTAM etc., after getting suggestions from District Programme Officers. (Vocational Training should be district specific/ area specific and to encourage Adolescent girls to get placements in the nearby places).

6. The Government examined the proposal of the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.162.25 lakh (Rupees One Crore sixty two lakh and twenty five thousand only) for conducting Vocational Training and Orientation Training Programme under Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme in 22 districts for the year 2011-12 at the level of first instalment of grants in aid released by Government of India for implementing the Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme for the year 2011-12. As and when, the further release is received from Government of India for the above scheme the additional sanction shall be made in future.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited under the following head of account:

2236-Nutrition-02-Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages-101-Special Nutrition Programmes- Schemes in the Eleventh Five year plan-III Centrally Sponsored-SI-Kishori Shakti Yojana Scheme – 72 Training (D.P.Code.2236-02-101-SI-7200)

8. The Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services is permitted to draw the amount as advance under Article 99 of Tamil Nadu Finance code Volume I for conducting Vocational Training and Orientation camps and for providing Training Kit, conducting camps/melas etc., to the beneficiaries if any balance is left because of effective negotiation and adjust the same after completion of the Programme with the Pay and Accounts Officer concerned and to send Utilisation Certificate to the Government.

9. The entire expenditure sanctioned in para 6 shall be met by Government of India 100% (Centrally Sponsored Scheme).

10. The Government also grant permission to the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services to disburse the amount to District Programme Officers/Child Development Project Officers for imparting Vocational Training to the Adolescent Girls through Non-Governmental Organisations / Reputed Institutions, ITI/VTPs under NSDP/NGOS registered under Health Department/NRHM/MAHALIR THITTAM etc., after getting suggestions from District Programme Officers, which can be district specific / area specific and to encourage Adolescent girls to get placement in the nearby places.

11. The Pay and Account Officer is directed to admit the bills as and when presented by the Principal Secretary / Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services, if otherwise found in order.

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
