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ORDER:-

In the letter 1st read above, Government of India have evolved broad frame work for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a "Vibrant Early Childhood Development Centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care.

2. Further, Government of India have also launched new components under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme inclusive of up-gradation of Anganwadi Centre building at ₹1.00 lakh per Anganwadi Centre including additional room for Anganwadi Centre cum Crèche in the sharing pattern of 75:25 between Centre and State.

3. In the letter 2nd read above, Government of India have conveyed the administrative approval of ₹3,306.00 lakh as 75% of Government of India share towards the up-gradation of 5,565 Anganwadi Centres during 2013-2014 and 2014-2015.

4. In the letter 3rd read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹118.85 crore under General Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2014-2015.

5. In the announcement 4th read above, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has made an announcement on the floor of Tamilnadu Legislative Assembly under rule 110 that 5,565 Anganwadi Centres will be up-graded to the tune of ₹ 55.65 crore @ ₹ 1.00 lakh per centre for the year 2014-2015.

6. In the letter 5th read above, based on the announcement, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that the Anganwadi Centres have a pivotal role in ensuring welfare of infant, adolescent girls and antenatal and postnatal mothers. It is therefore envisaged to reposition the Anganwadi Centre as a vibrant early child development and learning centre to provide awareness on developmentally appropriate early childhood interventions. To achieve this, the ambience of the Anganwadi Centres should be exhilarating way to provide complete and holistic development of the beneficiaries. To attract the children, the Anganwadi Centres are to be elevated by upgrading the Anganwadi Centres as Model Anganwadi Centres at a cost of ₹1.00 lakh per centre with basic infrastructure facilities. Initially 5,565 Anganwadi Centres are selected for up-gradation out of 54,439 centres for the year 2014-2015.

7. Government of India have not issued any separate guidelines regarding the up-gradation of Anganwadi Centres and activities to be done whereas indicated that the Anganwadi Centres are to be made as Model Anganwadi Centre by all means. Accordingly, 5,565 Anganwadi Centres which are functioning in a Government buildings were selected for up-gradation with the following criteria.

- Where the preschool children enrolled are more than 25.
- Where population is more.
- Where there is ample space for indoor and outdoor play activities.

8. As per the Hon'ble Chief Minister's announcement the "Model Anganwadi Centre" would have the amenities/infrastructure facilities such as construction of additional room with area of 100 sq.ft, construction/revamping the baby friendly toilets,

provision of water tank, wash basin, kitchen sink, water filter, out door play equipments, chairs and tables, rocking chair in the shape of duck and horse, school bag and water bottle, identity card, white washing, chappal stand, wall painting and carrying out of minor repairs to the Anganwadi Centres. The Anganwadi Centres selected for starting of Anganwadi-cum-Creche shall be given top priority under upgradation, where extension of one room for running crèches shall be carried out from ₹1.00 lakh sanctioned.

9. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction towards the up-gradation of 5,565 Anganwadi Centres @ ₹ 1.00 lakh per centre to the tune of ₹ 55.65 crore for the year 2014-2015 and issue necessary orders.

10. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-

- i. accorded sanction for a sum of ₹ 55.65 crore (Rupees fifty five crore and sixty five lakh only) to carryout the activities as detailed in Annexure -I for the up-gradation of 5,565 Anganwadi Centres as per the District-wise Annexure -II @ ₹1.00 lakh per centre for the year 2014-2015 in the sharing pattern of 75:25.
- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to authorize the District Project Officers to draw and incur the amount sanctioned above under Article 99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume I and to adjust the bill after incurring the expenditure.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to reallocate and redistribute the fund sanctioned above to the request of the District Project Officers of other districts for the activities within the overall budget as per Government of India norms.
- iv. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorised to redistribute the amount to the District Project Officers / Child Development Project Officers to carry out the activities at district / block level.
- v. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to send necessary Utilisation Certificate to the Government in time.
- vi. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to obtain the reimbursement of Government of India share funds.

11. The expenditure sanctioned in para 10 (i) above shall be debited under the Heads of account as per Annexure – III to this order.

12. The expenditure sanctioned at para 10 (i) will constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" for which the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due

course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met initially by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund for which orders will be issued by Finance (BG I) Department separately. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to apply for drawal of advance from the Contingency Fund in the prescribed format for the required quantum along with copy of this order. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes to Finance (SW) Department to include the expenditure in Supplementary Estimates for 2014-2015 at the appropriate stage.

13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.49992/Fin(SW)/2014, Dated. 15.09.2014 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1089 (One thousand and eighty nine).
