## ORDER:-

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Government of India, Ministry of Women and Child Development among other things have approved the proposal for provision of uniform sarees (2 sarees @ ₹ 200 per saree, per annum) and a name tag (Badge @ ₹ 25 per badge, per annum) to Anganwadi Workers/Anganwadi Helpers and Mini Anganwadi Worker with a sharing pattern of 90:10. Later, Government of India, in the reference second read above have enhanced the rate of uniform sarees as ₹ 300 per saree per annum and revised the sharing pattern as 75:25. In the reference third read above, Government of India has revised the sharing pattern as 60:40.

2. In the Government Order fourth read above, Government have sanctioned a sum of ₹411.95 lakh towards the procurement and supply of 1,50,896 Uniform Sarees (two sarees per worker) at the rate of ₹273 each and ₹18.86 lakh towards

the procurement and supply of name badges @ ₹25 per badge to Anganwadi Workers /Anganwadi Helpers for the year 2016-2017 in the sharing pattern of 60:40.

- 3. Government of India have conveyed administrative approval in Annual Programme Implementation Plan for a sum of ₹43202.90 lakh inclusive of ₹452.69 lakh towards providing Uniform Sarees to Anganwadi Employees in the sharing pattern of 60:40 during 2017-2018.
- 4. It is submitted that Government of India have also released a sum of ₹356.95 crore of Grants in Aid under the General Integrated Child Development Services Scheme component towards the continuous implementation of ICDS programme for the year 2017-2018 and the same has been credited into Government Account.
- 5. Based on the Government of India guidelines and revised norms, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal for the procurement and supply of Uniform sarees from Co-optex and Tamilnadu Textile Corporation Limited for 1,03,938 Anganwadi employees @ ₹300 each for two sarees per worker for the year 2017-2018 to the tune of ₹623.628 lakh.
- 6. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has obtained quotation from Co-optex and Tamilnadu Textile Corporation as ₹285 + 5% GST = ₹299.25 per saree and requested the Government to permit him to procure 2,07,876 sarees from Co-optex, Chennai/Tamilnadu Textile Corporation, Coimbatore @₹299.25 per saree to the tune of ₹622.07 lakh in the sharing pattern of 60:40 and to distribute the same through District Programme Officer to all Anganwadi employees as detailed below:-

i.	Total No. of sarees required @ 2 sarees per Anganwadi employee (total no.of employees 87,615x2)	1,75,230
ii.	Total Amount required @ ₹299.25 per saree (285+5% GST as per the quotation) (1,75,230 x 2 sarees per worker x ₹299.25)	₹ 5,24,37,578
iii.	Government of India share 60%	₹ 3,14,62,547
iv.	State Share 40%	₹2,09,75,031

## 7. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-

i. to accord sanction for a sum of ₹5,24,37,578 (Rupees five crore twenty four lakh thirty seven thousand five hundred and seventy eight only) towards the procurement and supply of 1,75,230 Uniform Sarees (two sarees per employee) from Co-optex/Tamilnadu Textile Corporation @ ₹299.25 per saree for the year 2017-2018 in the sharing pattern of 60:40 (Government of India 60% share of ₹3,14,62,547 and State share 40% of ₹2,09,75,031).

- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to procure and supply the Uniform Sarees from Co-optex/ Tamilnadu Textile Corporation Limited, Coimbatore through District Programme Officers to all Anganwadi Employees.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorised to draw and incur the amount sanctioned in para 7(i) above as advance under Article 99 of Tamilnadu Financial Code Volume I.
- iv. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is instructed to adjust the advance bill within the stipulated time.
- v. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to submit the Utilization Certificate in time.
- 8. The amount sanctioned in para 7(i) above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"2236-Nutrition - 02 Distribution of nutritious food and beverages - 101 - Special Nutrition Programmes —Central Sector Schemes-SF-Integrated Child Development Services Scheme — Phase III - 46 Clothing, Tentage and Stores (D.P.C:2236-02-101-SF-4602).

- 9. Necessary additional funds of ₹74.38 lakh will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation 2017-2018 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 7(i) above. Pending provision of such funds the Director of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the legislature by a specific inclusion in the supplementary estimates 2017-2018. The Director of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is also requested to send necessary draft explanatory notes to Government in Finance (SW) Department for inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2017-2018 at the appropriate time without fail.
- 10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O.No.11983/Fin(SW)/2018, Dated 13.03.2018 and with Additional Sanction Ledger No. 2986 (Two thousand nine hundred and eighty six).
