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### ORDER:

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Government of India have formulated guidelines for the decentralized procurement of Medicine Kits to Anganwadi Centres with the name of the Medicines and its technical specifications. This Medicine Kit consists of ready to use and dispensable medicine for remedying common ailments like cough, common cold, skin infections etc. Further, in Government of India Guidelines, it has been stated that the constitution of the Medicine Kit was finalized in consultation with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. The State Governments/UTs may continue with the same kit or may make modifications in the kit. Any modifications should however be done in consultation with the Health Department of the State Government/UT.

2. Based on the Government of India Guidelines, Government orders have been issued every year towards the sanction of expenditure involved to purchase the

medicines from Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited and to release the funds to Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited in advance under contra credit basis.

- 3. In the order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government orders have been issued towards the procurement and supply of Medicine kits to all Anganwadi Centres at the cost of ₹519.69 lakh for the year 2016-2017 in the sharing pattern of 60:40.
- 4. In the letters 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹162.43 crore as Grants in aid for the State of Tamilnadu towards the implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2017-2018 and the same amount has been credited in to State Government account.
- 5. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have approved the Annual Programme Implementation Plan (APIP) 2017-2018 for a sum of ₹43202.90 lakh inclusive of ₹544.39 lakh towards the procurement and supply of Medicine kit.
- 6. In the Announcement 5<sup>th</sup> read above, the Hon'ble Minister (SW&NMP) has made an announcement on the Floor of Assembly that Hygiene Kits will be provided to 54,439 Anganwadi Centres @ ₹ 244 per centre at a total cost of ₹ 1.40 crore.
- 7. In the letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent consolidated proposal for Medicine Kits and Hygiene Kits stating that provision of Hygiene Kit as announced by the Hon'ble Minister is meant for maintaining health and preventing diseases especially through cleanliness, it has been decided to procure and supply of Hygiene Kits within the amount allotted towards the procurement and supply of Medicine kits for the year 2017-2018. Hence, Medicine Kits and the Hygiene Kits have to be procured and supplied to all Anganwadi Centres so as to provide the essential health services through Anganwadi centres to the tune of ₹519.69 lakh.
- 8. The total amount required and district wise break-up is furnished in Annexure I. The tentative list of medicines proposed for procurement through Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited is furnished in Annexure-II and the list of Hygiene Kits proposed to be procured through centralized tender is furnished in the Annexure -III. The District-wise break up details of Medicine kits and Hygiene Kits proposed for supply is furnished in the Annexure-IV and V.
- 9. As of now, the Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited is supplying medicines through their respective District Drug ware houses to the District Programme Officers by issuing Pass Books in the name of the District Programme Officers concerned, this year also, the TNMSC may be requested to issue 32 Pass Books in the name of each District Programme Officer of the concerned District for the supply of Medicines. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

10. The budget abstract for the procurement of Medicine kit and Hygiene kit are detailed below:

### 11. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-

- i. sanction is accorded for a sum of ₹519.69 lakh and to permit the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to procure Medicine Kits and Hygiene Kits @ ₹1,000 per kit to 49,499 Main Anganwadi Centres and @ ₹500 per kit to 4,940 Mini Anganwadi Centres by following the State Norms and Government of India Guidelines.
- ii. the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to procure and supply Hygiene kits as per the announcement made @ ₹244 per centre to all Anganwadi Centres totalling to the tune of ₹132.83 lakh following Centralised Tender Procedures as per the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act,1998 and Rules, 2000.
- iii. the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to procure the Medicine Kits through Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.
- iv. the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to incur the transportation costs towards the procurement and supply of Medicine kits and Hygiene kits to the concerned blocks within the allotted budget amount and disburse the same to District Project Offices concerned.
- v. the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to authorise District Programme Officers/ Child Development Projects Officers to lift the medicines stipulated in the list as per Annexure -II according to their area specific needs from the concerned District drug warehouses as and when made available against the amount allotted in the pass book of Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation.
- vi. the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorised to draw and deposit the amount sanctioned in para 11(i)

above as far as Medicine Kit is concerned to the Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai by means of the Cheque/Demand Draft in favour of Personal Deposit account of the Managing Director, Tamilnadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.

- vii. the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to alter any changes in the quantity of Medicine Kits and Hygiene Kits (increase (or) decrease) as per the finalized rates.
- 12. The expenditure sanctioned in para 11(i) above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

"2236 Nutrition - 02 Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages - 101 Special Nutrition Programmes - Central sector schemes - SF Integrated Child Development Services Scheme-Phase-III- 66 Medicine" (D.P.C: 2236 02 101 SF 6600)

13. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is informed that the amount shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following head of account:-
