ORDER:

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Government of India have formulated guidelines to provide Pre-School Education Kit to the Child Centres (Anganwadi Centre) under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme namely Kit-A for the children in the age

group of 0-3 years and Kit-B for the children in the age group of 3-6 years and each Child Centre could be provided one or the other kit in alternate years (Kit 'A' in one year and Kit 'B' in another year). The above kits A and B were provided till 2012-2013.

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government of India have evolved a broad framework for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a "Vibrant ECD centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care. Further, Government of India have also revised the cost of Pre-School Education kit as detailed below:-

3. In the Government Order 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, orders were issued towards the procurement and supply of Pre-School Education Kit as per the revised rates to 54,439 Anganwadi Centres at the cost of ₹15,59,07,000 for the year 2013-2014.

4. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have framed revised guidelines with the provision of flexibility to States towards the provision of Pre-School Education (PSE) kits for Anganwadi Centres under strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme.

5. In the letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have conveyed administrative approval for ₹760.09 crore inclusive of ₹1,403.16 lakh in the sharing pattern of 90:10.

6. In the letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹559.13 crore as Grants-in-aid under General Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2014-2015.

7. Further, in letter No. 7<sup>th</sup> read above, Government of India have released 90% share of ₹1,403.16 lakh as an exclusive release for ensuring availability of Pre-School Education Kit (PSE) at all Anganwadi Centres.

8. In the letter 8<sup>th</sup> read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that the Preschool Education (PSE) is one of the most important components under Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. Preschool Education component of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme aims to provide a learning environment for the holistic development of children up to six years. In order to promote social, emotional, cognitive, motor, physical and aesthetic development of the child in the tender age, Preschool Education is given through play way method in the Anganwadi centres for which a syllabus is also framed, accordingly pre school kit materials are procured and supplied to promote pre-school education and motivate the children to attend the centres regularly. The proposed Pre-school Education (PSE) kit items for Main Anganwadi Centres @ ₹3,000 / centre and Mini Anganwadi Centres @ ₹1,500 / centre are detailed below:-

9. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of ₹15.59 crore towards the procurement and supply of Pre School Education Kits and issue necessary orders.

10. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-

- i. accord sanction for a sum of ₹15,59,07,000 (Rupees Fifteen crore fifty nine lakh and seven thousand only) towards the procurement and supply of Pre-School Education Kit @ ₹3,000 per centre for 49,499 Main Anganwadi Centres and @ ₹1,500 per centre for 4,940 Mini Anganwadi Centres for the year 2014-2015 in the sharing pattern of 90:10 between Government of India and State.
- ii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is permitted to procure and supply the Pre-school Education Kits following Centralized Tender Procedures as per the Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act 1998 and Rules, 2000 inclusive of Advertisement cost in the allocated Budget to ensure the uniformity across the State for the year 2014-2015.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 10(i) above in advance and incur the expenditure under Article-99 of Tamil Nadu Financial Code Volume-I.
- iv. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to submit necessary Utilization Certificate to Government within time.

11. The expenditure sanctioned in para 10(i) above shall be debited under the following Head of Account :-

2236. Nutrition-02-Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages- 101-Special Nutrition Programmes – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year plan - III Centrally Sponsored SF - Integrated Child Development Services Scheme - Phase-III. 24-Materials and supplies (D.P.C: 2236-02-101-SF-2408)

12. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 10(i) above shall be constitute an item of "New Instrument of service" and approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2015-2016. Pending approval of Legislature, the expenditure shall initially be met by drawl of an advance from the contingency fund. Orders regarding this will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme shall apply to the Government in Finance (BG-I) Department in prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2015-2016 to Finance (SW) Department without fail.

13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.21191/Fin(SW)/2015, Dated 16.04.2015 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.51 (Fifty one).
