#### ORDER:

In the letters first and second read above, Government of India have rolled out a flagship programme POSHAN Abhiyaan (National Nutrition Mission) across the country with three year budget of ₹ 9046.17 crore from 2017-2018 onwards.

2. In accordance with the Government of India Guidelines / norms, orders have been issued in the Government Order third read above, to rolled out the programme in the 5 districts viz., Ariyalur, Dindigul, The Nilgiris, Villupuram and Chennai in Tamilnadu for the year 2017-2018 and for setting up of State Project Management Unit (SPMU), District Level Help Desk (DLHD) and Block Level Help Desk (BLHD) with creation posts towards the implementation of National Nutrition Mission (NNM) for the year 2017-2018 and subsequent year for which remaining districts to be rolled out under POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM).

- 3. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of India have identified 6 more Districts namely Ramanathapuram, Thiruvallur, Tiruchirappalli, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari and Virudhunagar towards the implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) during the year 2018-2019 as Phase II and have released a sum of ₹1362.10 lakh as its 80% share during the year 2018-2019.
- 4. In the letter fifth read above, the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services has stated that no financial sanction has been accorded for staff to be recruited for the State Project Management Unit (SPMU) and District / Block level Help Desks in 5 Districts of Ariyalur, Dindigul, The Nilgiris, Villupuram and Chennai (Phase-I) except procurement of Smartphone, Growth monitoring devices and has requested the Government to sanction an expenditure of ₹46.30 crore for the implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) in 11 districts (Ariyalur, Dindigul, The Nilgiris, Villupuram and Chennai (Phase-I), and Ramanathapuram, Thiruvallur, Tiruchirappalli, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari and Virudhunagar (Phase-II)) and permission to carry out the activities under POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM).
- 5. After careful examination of the proposal of the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services, Government issue the following orders towards carrying out all activities under POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) emphasized in the Guidelines of POSHAN Abhiyaan issued by the Government of India/Norms towards the implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) during 2018-2019:
  - i. Administrative approval is accorded towards the roll out of the POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) in 6 Districts viz., Ramanathapuram, Tiruvallur, Tiruchirappalli, Tirunelveli, Kanyakumari and Virudhunagar (Phase-II Districts) during the year 2018-2019.
  - ii. Administrative sanction is accorded to the tune of ₹43,54,84,000 for implementation of POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) in the above Districts i.e., Phase –I Districts and Phase-II Districts for the year 2018-2019.
  - iii. Approval is accorded towards the setting up District Level Help Desk (DLHD) and Block Level Help Desk (BLHD) in the Phase –II Districts as detailed in the Annexure I of Government Order third read above.
- iv. Approval is accorded towards constituting District Convergence Plan Committee (DCPC) and Block Convergence Plan Committee (BCPC) in Phase-II District as per Annexure III & IV of Government Order third read above.
- v. Financial sanction is accorded to the tune of ₹21,53,25,000 the activities as detailed below subject to the conditions that the Government of India's Guidelines/Schematic norms should be followed:-

- vi. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services is directed to procure necessary equipments/accessories in respect of implementing the POSHAN Abhiyaan (NNM) through GeM portal with specifications prescribed by Government of India and as per the rate not exceeding the rate prescribed by Government of India.
- vii. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services is directed to submit the necessary Utilisation Certificate to Government within time.
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5(v) above shall be debited under the following New Head of Account:-

- 7. Necessary additional funds of 21,53,25,000 will be provided in RE/FMA 2018-2019. Pending provision of such funds, the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 5 above. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services shall include this additional expenditure while sending the proposal to the Government in Finance (SW) Department for inclusion in RE/FMA 2018-2019 without fail. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by a specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2018-2019. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes to Government in Finance (SW/BG-I) Department for inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2018-2019.
- 8. This orders issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O. No. 47685/Fin(SW)/2018, Dated 20.09.2018 and with ASL No. 1383 (One thousand three hundred and eighty three).
