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ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, based on the announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister on the floor of the Assembly under rule 110 of Tamilnadu Legislative Assembly orders were issued to provide 2 sets of colour dress to 2,01,032 Anganwadi Children in the age group of 2-5 years in the Districts of Chennai, Vellore, Trichy, Theni and Dindigal at the cost of Rs.4.30 crore for the year 2012-2013.

2. In the Budget Speech 2013-2014, it has been announced among others as follows:-

"During 2012-2013, a pilot scheme was launched to supply colour dresses to Anganwadi children in 5 Districts viz., Chennai, Vellore, Trichy, Dindigul and Theni. In 2013-2014, it will be extended to five more districts viz., Villupuram, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Nagapattinam and Tirunelveli. Rs.4.30 crore has been provided in this Budget for the supply of colour uniforms to Anganwadi children."

3. Based on the above Budget Speech, the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal stating that the main objective of the scheme was to motivate the parents to send their children to Anganwadi centers without any prejudice and most of the children attending Pre-School in Anganwadi centers are from economically backward families who cannot

afford to spend money on dresses to their children. She has also stated that the scheme was successfully implemented in the five districts of Phase -I and the feedback has been encouraging and the parents have requested to provide colour uniform instead of colour dresses.

4. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has proposed to continue the scheme to provide two sets of colour uniform instead of colour dress to 2,03,886 Anganwadi Children in the Districts of Chennai, Vellore, Trichy, Theni and Dindigul at the cost of Rs.5,09,71,500/- and also to extend the scheme to further five Districts of Villupuram, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Nagapattinam and Tirunelveli for the year 2013 - 2014 at a cost of Rs.4,20,60,500/-covering 1,68,242 children in the age group of 2 to 5 years, attending Pre-School in the Anganwadi centers. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has proposed to procure the uniform material and to stitch the uniforms through District Programme Officers / Child Development Project Officers according to the requirement in the Districts. The District wise beneficiaries are furnished as follows:-

The cost of stitched / readymade, colour uniform has been worked out as Rs.125/- per set towards material, tailoring, transportation and miscellaneous cost. The total expenditure towards providing two sets of colour uniform to children in selected 10 districts is detailed below:-

Total No. of Districts	:	5 +5 = 10
Total Beneficiaries	:	2,03,886 +1,68,242=3,72,128
Cost per set of colour uniform	:	Rs.125/- (including material, stitching, Transport and miscellaneous charges)
Cost of 2 sets of Colour uniforms	:	Rs.125 x 2 = Rs.250/-
Total Expenditure	:	Rs.250 x 3,72,128 children = Rs.9,30,32,000/-

5. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has requested the Government to issue orders on the following:-

(i) to sanction a sum of Rs.9,30,32,000/- (Rupees Nine crore Thirty Lakh and Thirty Two Thousand only) for the year 2013 – 2014 towards the procurement and supply of two sets of colour uniform to 3,72,128 Anganwadi children in the age group 2-5 years (in phase I and phase II Districts).

(ii) to permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner to authorise the District Programme Officers / Child Development Project Officers concerned to procure the colour uniforms as per the beneficiaries allotted to their Districts following Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules, 2000.

(iii) to permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner to authorise the District Programme Officers / Child Development Project Officers concerned to draw and disburse the amount as per their requirement to procure Colour Uniform materials.

(iv) to permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner to make inter-district transfer of Colour uniforms / funds based on the actual requirement /beneficiaries, (as the beneficiaries may vary) within the overall financial allocation.

6. After careful examination, Government accord sanction a sum of Rs.9,30,32,000/- (Rupees nine crore thirty lakh and thirty two thousand only) for the year 2013-2014 towards the procurement and supply of two sets of colour uniform to 3,72,128 Anganwadi children in the age group of 2-5 years at Chennai, Vellore, Trichy, Theni, Dindigul (Phase-I) and Villupuram, Ariyalur, Perambalur, Nagapattinam and Tirunelveli Districts.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 shall be debited to the following Head of Account.

"2236-Nutrition.02-Distribution of Nutritious food and Beverages-101 Special Nutrition Programme –Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-II State Plan-JN- Tamil Nadu Integrated Child Development Services Scheme Phase-III 46. Clothing, Tentage and Stores. (D.P.Code:2236 02 101 JN 4605)".

8. The amount sanctioned in para 6 above will constitute an item of "New instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature the expenditure will initially be met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding this will be issued by the Finance (BGI) Department separately. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner for Integrated Child Development Services Scheme shall apply to the Government in Finance (BGI) Department in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner for the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme shall also send necessary explanatory notes for the inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates, 2013-2014.

9. i. Government permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to authorise the District Programme Officers / Child Development Project Officers concerned to procure the colour uniforms as per the beneficiaries allotted to their Districts following Tamilnadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998 and Rules, 2000.

ii. Government permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to authorise the District Programme Officers / Child Development Project Officers concerned to draw the amount as per their requirement to procure Colour Uniform materials.

iii. Government permit the Principal Secretary/Special Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to make inter-district transfer of Colour uniforms/funds based on the actual requirement within overall financial allocation.
