## ORDER:

In the Letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Government of India have evolved a broad framework for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a "Vibrant ECD centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care.

2. Further, Government of India have revised interalia the unit cost and sharing pattern for the scheme Rent as detailed below:-

3. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, Government of India have conveyed the administrative approval for ₹ 760.09 crore inclusive of ₹ 2381.40 lakh as 75% of Government of India share towards the Rent for 12,876 Anganwadi Centres (₹ 2269.35 lakh) and 230 Project Offices (₹ 112.05 lakh) which are functioning in rented buildings under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme during 2014-2015.

4. In the letters 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Government of India have released a sum of ₹328.10 crore as Grants-in-aid under General Integrated Child Development Services Scheme component for the year 2015-2016.

5. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has sent proposal for sanction of rent to 12,876 Anganwadi Centres (out of 54,439 total Anganwadi Centres) functioning in rented building of which 8,230 Anganwadi Centres are in rural areas, 4,195 Anganwadi Centres in urban areas and 451 Anganwadi Centres are in Metropolitan area for the year 2014-2015. The Details of total expenditure of ₹ 2521.50 lakh towards the rent for Anganwadi Centres is detailed below and the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme has requested the Government to issue necessary orders.

6. After careful examination, Government issues the following orders:-

- i. Enhanced rate of Rent to project offices and Anganwadi Centres functioning in rented buildings in the sharing pattern of 75:25 and 90:10 respectively under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in MISSION MODE is approved.
- ii. Accord Sanction for a sum of ₹ 25,21,50,000 (Rupees Twenty five crore twenty one lakh and fifty thousand only) towards the Rent for 12,876 Anganwadi Centres which are functioning in rented buildings as per the annexure in the sharing pattern of 90:10 (Government of India share ₹ 2269.35 lakh State share ₹ 252.15 lakh) under restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme for the year 2014-2015.
- iii. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorised to draw and distribute the funds to the District Project Officers as per their requirement detailed in Annexure.
- iv. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorised to reallocate funds among districts based on the actual requirement within overall budget as per Government of India guidelines.
- v. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to send necessary utilization certificate to Government within time.

7. The amount sanctioned in para 6 (ii) above shall be debited under the following head of account

"2236-Nutrition 02 Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages 101 Special Nutrition Programme – scheme in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – III Centrally sponsored – SF Integrated Child Development Services Scheme – Phase III – 06 Rent, Rates and Taxes-01-Rent". (D.P.C 2236-02-101-SF-0615)

8. Necessary additional funds of ₹ 20,34,29,000 will be provided in RE/FMA 2015-2016. Pending provision of additional funds in RE/FMA 2015-2016, the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw and disburse the

amount sanctioned in paragraph 6(ii) above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2015-2016. The Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is requested to include this additional expenditure while sending the proposal for RE/FMA 2015-2016 and also send necessary explanatory note to include this expenditure in the supplementary estimates 2015-2016 to the Government in Finance (SW) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.62452/Fin(SW)/2015, Dated 27.11.2015 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1406 (One thousand four hundred and six)
