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ORDER:-

In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above Government of India have evolved a broad framework for implementation of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in the "Mission Mode" by strengthening and restructuring of ICDS. The Anganwadi Centre will be repositioned as a "Vibrant ECD centre" to become the first village outpost for health, nutrition and to ensure holistic physical, psychosocial, cognitive and emotional development of children under 6 years of age in nurturing, protective, child friendly and gender sensitive family, community, programme and policy environments with greater emphasis on children under 3 and promotion of optimal early childhood care, development & learning including maternal care. Under the State ICDS Mission, Government of India have approved the organisational setup with various human resources inclusive of Contractual Staff.

2. In the letters 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> read above Government of India have approved and conveyed the staffing structure for Consultants/outsourced personnel at various levels

the Integrated Child Development Services Scheme Mission for Tamilnadu as detailed below:-

3. Government of India have also approved and conveyed the terms of Reference for consultants/outourced personnel under the ICDS Mission as detailed below:-

4. In the letter 4<sup>th</sup> read above, Government have approved to appoint only one Consultant for Monitoring and Evaluation.

5. In the letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above the Commissioner, Integrated Child Development Services scheme has sent proposal to appoint a Senior Consultant (Monitoring) on contractual basis for a period of one year (extendable for 2 years) by publishing advertisements in two prominent news papers and as per the guidelines of Government of India by fixing the pay of ₹70,000 per month at annual recurring expenditure of ₹8,40,000 in the sharing pattern of 75:25 between Government of India and State Government

6. After careful examination the Government have permitted the Director, Integrated Child Development Services Scheme to appoint a Consultant on contractual basis by fixing remuneration at ₹50,000 (Rupees fifty thousand only) per month for a period of one year under Restructured pattern of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme in Mission Mode for Monitoring by following the guidelines of Government of India on the qualification, age, experience etc.

7. Accordingly, Government accord sanction of a sum of ₹6,00,000 (Rupees six lakh only) towards the recurring expenditure on the appointment of one Consultant at ₹50,000 per month in the sharing pattern of 75:25 between Government of India and Government of Tamilnadu.

8. The expenditure sanctioned on para 7 above shall be debited under the following Head of account:

2236 – Nutrition- 02 – Distribution of Nutritious Food and Beverages -101 – Special Nutrition programmes – schemes in the Twelfth Five year plan VI. schemes shared between State and Centre UE- Strengthening and Restructuring of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme 33- Payments for professional and Special services – 04 – contract payment. (D.P. Code. 2236 -02-101 –UE - 3345)

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 will be provided in RE/FMA 2014-2015. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2014-2015, the Director of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is authorized to draw and incur the above expenditure. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015. The Director of Integrated Child Development Services Scheme is also requested to include the above expenditure in RE/FMA 2014-2015 while sending the proposal to Finance (Social Welfare) Department without fail and is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes to Finance (BG-I) Department to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015 at the appropriate time.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (SW) Department vide its U.O.No.37923/Fin(SW)/2014, Dated.22.07.2014 and Additional Sanction Ledger number.756 (Seven hundred and fifty six).
