ORDER:-

In the G.O. first read above, orders have been issued permitting the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation to conduct the 47th India Tourist and Industrial Fair 2022 at Island Grounds, Chennai and administrative sanction was also issued for a sum of Rs.126.00 lakhs to meet the expenditure towards erection of pavilion by Government Departments in the above Fair. However, due to Omicron, the above fair was cancelled.

2. In the letter 2nd read above the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation has stated that, the Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation has been conducting the India Tourist and Industrial Fair at Island Ground, Chennai-9 every year since 1974. The Fair provides an ideal platform to showcase the welfare schemes and development programs of the various Government Departments to the visiting public.

3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation has also stated that now, it is proposed to conduct the 47th India Tourist and Industrial Fair 2023 at Island Grounds for 70 days from the 2nd week of December 2022 to March 2023.

4. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development corporation has therefore, requested the Government as follows:-

- A) To issue Government Order to Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation for conducting the "47th India Tourist and Industrial Fair 2023" at Island Grounds, Chennai-9 for 70 days from the 2nd week of December 2022 to March 2023.
- B) To sanction funds of Rs.126.00 Lakhs for 28 Tamil Nadu Government Departments for the erection of pavilions for the 47th India Tourist and Industrial Fair 2023 at Island Grounds, Chennai-9 as was done in previous year Fairs.

5. The Government, after careful examination, accept the above proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation and orders as follows:

- i. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation is permitted to conduct the 47th India Tourist and Industrial Fair 2023 at Island Grounds, Chennai for 70 days by strictly following COVID-19 Standard Operating Procedures/Health Protocols issued by the Government.
- ii. Administrative sanction is accorded for Rs.1,26,00,000/- (Rupees one crore and twenty six lakhs only) for various Government Departments for the erection of pavilions for the 47th India Tourist and Industrial Fair 2023 at Island Grounds, Chennai as was done in previous years as follows:-

6. The above permission is granted subject to the following sanction:-

- i. The organisers shall ensure that the Standard Operating procedures for Covid-19 applicable during the time of event enforced scrupulously.
- ii. The Micro Small and Medium Enterprises Department shall erect a separate stall in the above Fair.
- iii. The Administrative Departments participating in the above Fair shall restrict their expenditure within the overall amount, for which administrative sanction accorded against their Department mentioned at para 5 above.
- iv. The Director of Tourism/Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Tourism Development Corporation shall furnish the details on the ticket collections during the Trade Fair, remittance into Government account, Collection of rent, if any from the exhibiting Departments etc., separately to Government for study.
- v. This expenditure shall be incurred within the funds allocated to the Government Department concerned during the financial year 2022-2023.
- vi. Permission is granted to install combined stalls by the inter-related Departments, by joining together instead of going for separate stall for each and every Department.
- vii. The following administrative Departments in Government shall issue financial sanction for the amount, as mentioned in para 5 above, of this order, in anticipation of the receipt of necessary proposal from their Head of Departments.

- ix) To install a combined stall, the Revenue Department in Secretariat shall issue financial sanction as mentioned in item (ii) above of this order, to the implementing agency, to be selected by that Department, as per the rules in force.
- x) The erection work of stalls for Government Departments shall be completed prior to the inauguration of the Trade Fair.
- xi) Government will not entertain proposals from the Government Departments or Districts, for ratification of additional expenditure incurred over and above the amount mentioned in para 5 above, of this order.
